This is a possible suggested email to send out with the personal safety flyers. We recommend it be strong and hopefully get everyone to open and read the information. We also hope to have some physical flyers available (at least to post) at the picnic. Finally if there are neighbors who are not on the email list, then we recommend delivering physical copies to them.

Important!

The HOA security committee believes that the burglaries in our neighborhood occurred could have been avoided. The thieves had easy access through:

- Open garages, open windows, dog doors and unlocked doors.
- Vehicles were most often in the driveway not the garage.

The best way to make your home safer is to READ and implement the information in the attached documents.
