Budget: The 2021 budget, proposed 2022 budget, and the July through September income and expense statements were presented by Jerry Simon.

There are no plans for foreseeable future projects to be added into the budget other than a request for another picnic table for Laguna Seca. The community will be queried by way of a survey monkey before the decision is made regarding the purchase and placement. A line item was added to the budget for the monthly expense of the board meetings and the annual meeting to be held at the Los Duranes Community Center.

President's Report:

CCR Committee:

CCR update - The CCR committee will meet next week to review changes needed to bring our CCR up to date. We have also found a lawyer who will review the documents for \$250 per hour, at a minimum of 3 hours, so we need to allocate about \$1000 in our budget; The updated document will hopefully be filed by the first of the year.

Social Committee:
