All students of Nursing Training Center, LLC are being asked to cooperate in mitigating and reducing the spread of COVID-19. Completing this questionnaire is one step in our efforts to assess current risk and respond appropriately. It is imperative that students do not report to class or clinicals while experiencing the below listed symptoms.

Within the last 14 days, have you, a family member or someone in your household been in direct contact with someone for at least 5 minutes who has been diagnosed or tested positive for COVID-19? Yes No

If you answered yes, you are not allowed to attend class or clinical.

In the last 48 hours, have you had any of the following NEW symptoms? Check all that apply:
 Fever of 100 F (37.8 C) or above or possible fever symptoms like alternating chills and
 Chills or repeated shaking with chills Muscle aches Sore throat Loss of smell or taste, or a change in taste Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea Headache

If you checked any of the above, you are not allowed to attend class or clinical.

Within the past 14 days, have you had these types of contact with someone with a lab-confirmed case of COVID-19 while you weren't both wearing masks or, when touching shared items, you weren't wearing gloves? Check all that apply:

Shared a home Been within 6 feet of each other for at least 5 minutes Been sneezed on or coughed on Shared eating or drinking utensils or other items Hugged or kissed

If you checked any of the above, you are not allowed to attend class or clinical.

Contact your health care provider for advice if you get new symptoms or if you have close contact with someone with lab-confirmed COVID-19. Close contact means living with that person, being within 6 feet of that person for more than 5 minutes or being exposed to their sneezing or coughing while not both wearing masks. Close contact also means touching their mucus, saliva or shared items while not wearing gloves.
