DINING ASSISTANT (DA) PROGRAM

Purpose:

- a. To Prepare Dining Assistants in long term care facilities to feed the assigned residents in a dignified and caring manner.
- b. Prepare the Dining Assistant to function as part of the health care team.
- c. Make Dining Assistant aware of the principles of nursing as it applies to delegation by a nurse.

Requirements to be a dining assistant trainee:

1. Be 17 years old or older,
2. Be able to read, speak and understand English,
3. Attend class and the clinical rotation,
4. Not listed on the Nurse Aide registry for: abuse, neglect or misappropriation.
5. Navy blue shirt or scrub top, Khaki or Navy-blue pants or scrub pants (no blue jeans), close toed shoes (for the clinical hour).
6. Attend required hours (total 9).
7. *Depending on the clinical site, may need* Covid-19 vaccine series, TB test and criminal records check.

Cost: \$75 Tuition includes: Borrowed book, electronic information, handouts, course and clinical.
