

## NURSING TRAINING CENTER (NTC) HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOL

To Nursing Training Center (NTC) Students:

Our expectation is that every individual on our campus—faculty, student, vendor, or other visitor—will follow Nursing Training Center’s health and safety protocols.

***As of now, those required protocols include:***

**1. Covid-19 Vaccine Series and Boosters (as required by state law) are required.**

### **2. Face Coverings**

- Face coverings must be worn at all times in the building (students who have been fully vaccinated are not required to wear their mask but can choose to wear one)
- Face coverings are provided at the door and to cover nose, mouth, and chin; and
- Any exceptions to the face covering requirement must be documented.

### **2. Physical Distancing**

- Maintain physical distance (at least six feet) as much as possible, indoors or out understanding this may be difficult with certain skills to be performed.

### **3. Hygiene**

- Wash hands thoroughly (at least 20 seconds, with soap and water);
- Apply hand sanitizer regularly, especially after coming in contact with “high-touch” areas (doors, counters, desks, manikins, equipment, etc.);
- Regularly disinfect your high-touch areas (desks, counters, phones, door and draw handles, etc.);
- Follow [CDC guidelines](#) for care and handling of the face covering; and
- Dispose of tissues immediately after use.

### **4. Concern for the Health of Others on Campus**

- Staff and Students are required to perform the NTC COVID-19 Daily Self-Assessment (see website if need one nursingtrainingcenter.com) and check their temperatures before reporting to campus;
- Temperatures will be checked when entering the building;
- Staff and students should **NOT** come to campus if they:
  - Have a fever of 100.4 degrees or above;
  - Are experiencing any of the [other symptoms of COVID-19](#) (these include shortness of breath, chills, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell); or
  - Have been exposed to someone diagnosed with COVID-19, tested for COVID-19, or with symptoms of COVID-19.
- People in the campus community with influence over others (faculty, etc.) should ensure that:

- All of those over whom they have influence follow social distancing and face covering requirements when in the classroom when possible;
  - Those with symptoms of or potential exposure to COVID-19 know they should not come to campus;
  - If any symptoms are apparent if observing employees at work, send them home immediately; and
  - Students with significant concerns regarding their own health do not feel coerced into coming to campus (you can makeup time missed for 60 days after missed).
- All in the campus community should:
    - Ask those not wearing face coverings within labs, or other indoor spaces with others present to do so;
    - Ask those failing to adhere to physical distancing when possible to step away;
    - Regularly review ODH coronavirus website <https://coronavirus.ohio.gov/wps/portal/gov/covid-19/home>
    - Be kind and considerate to each other.
