The only town size comparable to Plymouth that hasn't changed their gov't form is Brookline, which has 240 town mtg reps [vs Plymouth 135] 16 precincts [vs 15]

100 appointments [vs 380] tax rate $\$ 9.46$ [vs \$16.81]

Towns much smaller than Plymouth have changed to a more efficient and effective style including Amesbury, Bridgewater, Franklin, Gloucester, but especially notable LESS THAN 20,000 population such as - East Longmeadow, East Hampton, Gardner, Greenfield, Newburyport, Southbridge, and Winthrop and even smaller North Adams and Palmer I <15,0001

- There are 4 types of approved governments among Mass Cities and towns namely:
- Mayor- Council
- Mayor-Council, Alderman
- Council- Manager
- Mayor, Town Manager- Council; councils can be any number of members most often 9-12 members representing all parts of town and some at-large members ALL ELECTED .
