Spray Vaccination Field Application Guide

Coarse spray vaccination is used to apply live vaccines such as Infectious Bronchitis (IB), and Avian Metapneumovirus (aMPV).

Before Spraying

- Use a dedicated, clean sprayer reserved only for vaccination
- Before first use, disassemble, inspect and clean all nozzles, filters, and lines with clean water, do not use soap or disinfectant
- Choose coarse spray nozzles producing droplets 150–200 μm in diameter
- Re-assemble the unit and perform a dry run with water only to check spray pattern, pressure and nozzle function (no need to turn off fans for this run)
- Keep vaccines refrigerated at 2–8 °C until mixing; never freeze
- Use the full volume within 1 hour of mixing
- Use cool (50°F), clean, chlorine-free water for mixing (usually 2-3 gallons)- preferably distilled water with vaccine stabilizer
- Ensure the stabilizer is mixed thoroughly to avoid plugging of the nozzle
- Avoid vaccinating at the warmest time of day during the summer months

During Spraying

- Turn fans off prevent drift
- Dim lighting just enough to keep birds calm and stationary
- Run the sprayer before entering the barn to acclimate birds to the loud sound
- The sprayer should start at one end of the barn and walk slowly along the inside feeder or drinker line, applying spray evenly in a gentle, rain-like pattern across the flock 30-50cm over the birds' heads that settles on birds' heads, eyes, and beaks (not a mist)
- Maintain a slow, consistent pace and slightly overlap each pass to ensure full coverage
- If possible, a second person should walk ahead to calmly move birds aside, keeping them evenly spread and preventing crowding during spraying
- Avoid spraying walls, feeders, or floors
- Can add an approved food-grade dye to the vaccine solution to visually confirm even coverage; check several birds to ensure droplets are visible on feathers and faces
- Gently stir or agitate the vaccine solution throughout application to prevent settling

After Spraying

- Return fans and lights to normal settings
- Immediately rinse tank, lines, and nozzles with clean, chlorine-free water
- Can rinse with isopropyl alcohol or vinegar before storage
- Remove nozzles, inspect for wear or clogging, and air dry
- Store sprayer in a clean, dry area, away from chemicals or dust
