A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CODE COMPLIANCE POLICY MANUAL AND CODE COMPLIANCE FEES; AND DESIGNATING THE CODE COMPLIANCE/ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO PREPARE, SIGN AND SERVE WRITTEN CITATIONS ON PERSONS IN VIOLATION OF PLANNING, ZONING, BUILDING, MOBILE HOME PARK, AND STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC PLACES ORDINANCES APPLICABLE WITHIN THE PAHRUMP REGIONAL PLANNING DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Nye County Board of Commissioners (BOARD), at its November 17, 2000 meeting, created the position of Code Compliance/Enforcement Officer; and

WHEREAS, said Board has reviewed the proposed Code Compliance Manual and fees for the Pahrump Regional Planning District (PRPD), which said Manual provides a process for achieving compliance with the various planning, zoning, building, mobile home park, and streets, sidewalks and public places ordinances applicable within the PRPD; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that the Code Compliance/Enforcement Officer(s) must be conveyed the authority to issue citations in order to perform the requirements of the position.

## NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- A. The Board hereby adopts the Code Compliance Manual for the Pahrump Regional Planning District; and, in order to make adjustments to the process, authorizes the Planning Director to modify the forms attached to the Manual.
- B. In accordance with NRS 171.17751, any and all persons performing the function of Code Compliance/Enforcement Officer within the Pahrump Regional Planning District are designated to have the authority to prepare, sign and serve written citations on persons accused of violating a planning, zoning, building, mobile home park or streets, sidewalks and public places ordinance applicable to the PRPD.

## C. PENALTIES

 Any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of any planning, zoning, building, mobile home park or streets, sidewalks and public places ordinance applicable within the PRPD is D. FEES. Pursuant to the requirements of the Code Compliance Manual, Code Compliance Officers shall keep an accurate accounting of all time and materials used. When a case is ready to be concluded or reaches the point of disposition Code Compliance Officers shall use the following fee schedule in calculating all costs:

•	Long Distance Telephone Per Minute	.25
•	Forms, Letters, Memos, Etc. Per Page	.50
•	Certified Mailing Per Each Mailing	4.00
•	Regular Mailing Per Each Mailing	.50
•	Sheriff and District Attorney	<b>Actual Costs</b>

THE CODE COMPLIANCE MANUAL AND CODE COMPLIANCE FEES BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.
