## ANNUAL REPORT, 2019

His Work Foundation has provided needed assistance to the Church in Africa for eight years, totaling almost \$400,000. This has been provided in small grants (not over \$5,000) to mostly rural parishes, churches and schools in remote parts of Africa. Our goal is to assist church and education projects in areas which are mostly overlooked by other (mostly larger) foundations. For practical purposes, we have no overhead or operating expenses.

Priests who apply for grants must have the approval of their bishop or religious superior who are known to us personally and are responsible for grant accounting. To make the process as simple as possible, grant requests are encouraged to be on a single page describing the need, grant amount and people who will benefit. Grants are made by wire transfer only to churches and schools, never to individuals. No one receives a salary, travel expenses or compensation in any form.

During the year 2019 foundation income from contributions was \$114,479. Grants for this period totaled \$149,421. Income was not sufficient to meet all the grant requests. To accommodate this, money was released from a reserve fund established in 2018. Grants from the foundation were sent to five African nations of Tanzania, Kenya, Ethiopia, Sudan and Eritrea. These grants were issued to 41 priests for 48 projects which include church construction and operations, school construction and operating costs, public health, orphan care, education, catechist training, and church furnishings (altars, icons, pews, tabernacles, etc.).

### DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS BY CATEGORY

The total of small grants (under \$5,000) during 2019 totaled \$149,421. All of those grants went to rural African churches and schools and human welfare, specifically:

24% Public Health issues including water systems, solar electric, sanitation

12% Food and nutrition including orphan care, elder care, malnutrition

11% Education including girls rescue and education, elementary schools, catechist training

19% Church construction

23% Church furnishings including altar, tabernacles, ambo, icons, pews, crosses

5% School construction

6% Vehicle and other including repairs and items which didn't fit into another category

### LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

We all know that looking forward can sometimes be very tricky. Though we try our very best, we must trust in God's guidance and try to align ourselves with whatever His plan might be. In 2018 an unexpected, and unrestricted gift to His Work Foundation of \$200,000 was placed in a 'reserve account' from which we have been able to withdraw periodically to meet the objectives of the foundation and the projects which we sponsor in Africa. Consequently, we have dispensed all of our 'normal operating funds' in accordance with the stated goals of the foundation. Should grant request and needs exceed our normal operating funds, it is our intent to utilize the above mentioned unrestricted gift to meet the annual needs.
