

BY THE NUMBERS:

So far in 2021, The Inn has welcomed 2450 total individuals, including children traveling with their families. We received 271 individuals in July, 458 in August, and 299 in September. The majority of migrants in the past few months have been from Brazil, Venezuela, Columbia, Haiti and Cuba.



Please welcome Gustavo Daniel Rodríguez Atlahua to The Inn of Southern Arizona! His position is funded through a grant from Church World Service until March 31st, 2022. He is funded to determine which guests qualify for

case management and refer those guests for additional help with their asylum cases. Today, as I (Diane Everhart) was working in the clothing area at FUMC with two dedicated volunteers, doing our usual sorting and packaging of clothing, we looked up and saw a family of four who had just come down the steps. After greeting them and asking if I might help them, the wife

asked "No, where is the shelter?" I explained we'd had to move to a hotel due to Covid-19 and this space, our previous location, was now being used as a storage and supply area. She began to explain that in October of 2019 they were guests of The Inn, as her husband pulled out his phone to show me photos of their stay. He pointed out the corner of the room where they slept and showed pictures of his daughter being served a meal, his son playing in the "family" room.

This family was seeking asylum from Russia and the wife/mother, who spoke a little more English, expressed the uncertainty they'd felt when they arrived and their gratefulness for the help they had received. Now living in California, they said they were taking a road trip and this was the most stop on their journey. And that they had brought donations for The Inn! They expressed how very important it was to them to give back to the shelter that had helped them. The family then brought in 35 pounds of fresh apples, a case of breakfast cereal, four bags filled with packages of cookies, and four large bags of clothing! As kids produced their "artwork" when they passed through the Inn, we taped their pictures all over the walls and doors for everyone to admire. Well, their daughter looked for the picture she had made when they were with us and, after finding it, took it to the desk and wrote "Thank you very much!" She then added her name and today's date. As they walked around, I realized this visit, so important to them, was equally as moving for me; how rewarding it was to see how they had thrived since their stay here almost two years before.

As they were leaving, they asked if they could take photos; I said of course they could. Then they wanted a photo with me. I also asked if I could get one with them as well and they said "yes." I had tears in my eyes as they left. We so seldom know what happens to our guests after they leave and head to their sponsors. It was a joy and privilege to be at FUMC when this family returned to express gratitude and say what it meant to find The Inn, a safe, helpful and loving place. My heart is filled to overflowing. What we do matters, and we are remembered.

It is our privilege to share in the journey of migrants arriving in Tucson, on their way to loved ones across the U.S. Covid testing is essential for the health of our migrant families as well as volunteers, so as they arrive in Tucson, medical specialists at Casa Alita administer testing and perform general wellness checks. We try to assist by bringing as many individuals to the Inn as possible. Partnership has been a part of our advocacy work from the beginning. Currently, the flow of arrivals continues to fluctuate.
