In our current position as a sub-awardee of the county and with our new location nearer the airport, we are now able to receive many more guests; 1,237 in October alone! We are also very aware that having our shelter located in a hotel rather than in a congregate setting is not ideal for the personal, individual interaction with our guests that we all prefer. PLEASE KNOW that there are still wonderful and much-needed ways to interact and help with our families and kiddos! If you are able to spend a few hours providing hospitality, please help fill those empty shifts by signing up on the Signup Genius. Each shift has room for two volunteers, and we can use every bit of help we can get!

A GREAT BIG THANK YOU goes out to all who have and continue to sign up to help with hospitality shifts. Your work is invaluable and is what keeps the Inn's doors open to welcoming our guests. For those who have not yet filled out a volunteer form and have any extra time for a hospitality shift, to help with clothing donations and sorting, fundraising, or to help with occasional transportation needs, we need and would greatly appreciate your assistance! Providing hospitality, with guidance from the Inn staff, is rewarding and satisfying, whether delivering support onsite or helping with transportation. Guests have been screened and are Covid-19 negative before proceeding to our hotel site. In addition, we follow all Covid protocol on premises and during transportation. Please consider volunteering!

Hospitality shifts are to help on site from 8 am-1 pm, 1 pm-5 pm and 5 pm-9pm. including weekends.
We especially need evening and weekend volunteers!

Those interested in other areas of volunteer work off-site will be contacted by the person overseeing your area of interest.

Each person providing hospitality is important during our guests' stay! Regardless of border conditions, you, as volunteers, play a huge role in our guests' experience in the US, providing a sense of security, acceptance, and graciousness and we greatly value your commitment to our mission. As we anticipate the repeal of Title 42 in Mid-December, we are expecting the number of guests to increase again.
