RESOLUTION 01-2016
RATIONALIZATION OF TFOE-PEI ELECTORATE BODY
FOR 2026 NATIONAL ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, the current state of The Fraternal Order of Eagles – Philippine Eagles, Incorporated still has to stabilize due to the transfer of several regions from the other factions of the fraternity.

WHEREAS, several regions that transferred are still in the process of recruiting new members to activate clubs in order to comply with the required number of clubs to be declared to be in good standing.

WHEREAS, the requirement for members of the national assembly to qualify to vote and be voted is that their regions should be in good standing with having the required number of clubs in their region as one of the requirements.

WHEREAS, if the rules will be applied strictly, only a few will be qualified to be candidates and not all will be allowed to vote thus the election would not reflect the true voice of the members.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT RESOLVED that for the purpose of the 2026 Elections, a rationalized election scheme will be followed with the number voters per region will be proportional to the number of clubs of the concerned region as follows:

Number of Clubs	Number of Voters
6 or more	5
4-5	4
3	3
2	2
Less than 2	1

RESOLVED FURTHER that ***the clubs referred to should be in good standing (at least 25 members renewed for EY 2026) and this scheme shall be applied for the 2026 elections only*** while the fraternity is still stabilizing. Succeeding elections shall adhere to the policies set forth in the Eagles Constitution and the Philippine Eagles Election Code.
