COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS

RESOLUTION 02-2016 ABSENTEE VOTING FOR 2026 NATIONAL ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, The Fraternal Order of Eagles – Philippine Eagles, Incorporated has its regions spread in the different areas of the world thereby creating a challenge in accounting for the votes of those national assemblymen abroad.

WHEREAS, failure to account the votes of overseas eagles regions will not reflect the actual voice of the eagle members as its representation will not be heard during the elections.

WHEREAS, the advent of technology presents a venue by which communications between the COMELEC and those abroad can be done in real time.

WHEREAS, technology presently available can be utilized to account the votes of the fraternity's international regions

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT RESOLVED that for the purpose of the 2026 Elections, absentee voting of international regions will be allowed utilizing the different platforms available (zoom, google meet, video teleconferencing using other social media platforms) observing the following rules:

1. International Regions shall signify their intention to avail of the absentee voting to the COMELEC not later than November 7, 2026.
2. The COMELEC shall prescribe the schedule for the absentee voting before the actual 2026 National Elections.
3. The absentee voting must be administered by at least three (3) COMELEC Commissioners, acting as Board of Canvassers, present during the video teleconferencing.
4. The absentee voters shall present their votes to the Board of Canvassers thru their cameras.
5. The Board of Canvassers shall take a picture of their ballots as proof of voting.
6. The votes shall be tallied and an official certificate of cavass shall be accomplished by the Board of Canvassers.
7. The election returns for absentee voting shall be integrated in the actual National election returns

RESOLVED FURTHER that this scheme shall already be applied for the 2026 elections. Further revisions of the Absentee Voting scheme shall be presented to the National Assembly for their concurrence.
