FINANCIAL UPDATE

From Doug Sweeder—Finance Chair

Thank you to St. Paul's family for supporting our missions and daily needs thru these trying times.

Currently, we are doing OK financially. We are in wait-and-see mode for 2021.

In 2020, we received a Paycheck Protection Program loan of \$10,400 for expenses in 2020.

In 2021, we received a Paycheck Protection Program 2nd Draw loan of \$13,800 for expenses in 2021.

All Forgiveness documents for the 2020 loan have been submitted, but the SBA suspended forgiveness to actively make loans for 2021. The forgiveness process will resume after 2021 loans are made. We think both loans will be converted to grants as we have followed the PPP spending guidelines meticulously.

Our two new roofs, paid for by our Insurance company, should be starting in the next 60 days. We are really looking forward to this completion.



Food Drive Update

Our food collection was held from the beginning of Lent to Easter Sunday. The total collection was considered at a value of around \$300. The food was delivered to Lighthouse of Oakland County. Pastor Maurice Horne and Witness Chair, Marcus Kelley, met at the church and transported the supplies to the building on Woodward.
