Fame at last!

Historic England has recognised the “historic and design interest” of Fieldend’s landscape and given it Grade II listed status. The listing requires local planning authorities to consult with Historic England before approving any work that will affect the grounds at Fieldend and will provide an extra layer of protection to the neighbourhood by prioritising Fieldend when developing local conservation policies. The listing praised Fieldend’s combination of “the built and natural environments to engender a sense of community and identity”.

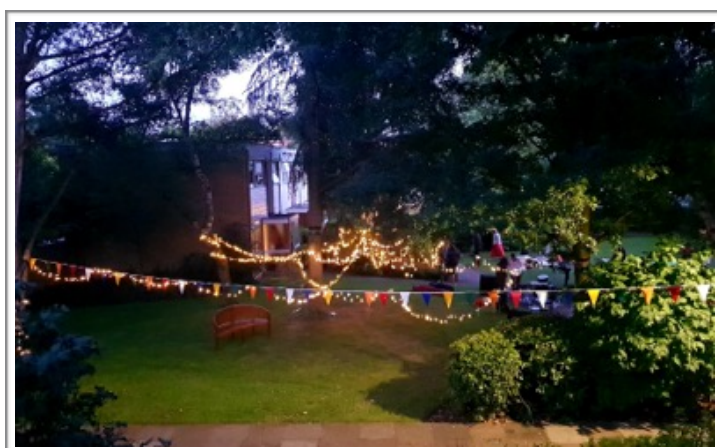


Who needs Glastonbury?
