### **Invoices:**

- Due to rising costs of landscaping and maintenance we were forced to increase dues from \$129 to \$136 annually.

### PLEASE REMEBER...

Please help to keep our neighborhood a beautiful place to live. Repair any exterior damage to your home and pressure wash if needed. Don't forget to call 311 for large item pick up at least 2 days before your pick up day. Please do not leave large items on the curb for an entire week or more.

Grass can be difficult to grow in certain areas, try ivey or similar ground cover on slopes or extremely shady areas. Now is a great time to plant! You can raise the canopy on your trees to let more sun in or if all else fails just bring in pine needles or mulch. Help grass grow by cleaning up leaves in the Fall!

#### PARK IMPROVEMENTS

- The Board completed some large infrastructure and maintenance projects at the Park and Front Island and is continuing progress on those throughout the Spring. Watch for "Park Closed" sign when there is dangerous work being done.
- The front entry had plant replacement and added a new Japanese Maple.
