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General Information

Any student who is interested in becoming a Kelley's Dance Craze Competition Team Dancer, must be accepted into the program by audition. All students auditioning must attend the two week KDC Summer Intensive (August 11-14, August 18-22). After auditions, and upon acceptance into the program, they will officially begin classes in September 2025. The minimum age required to audition is 6 years old by December 1, 2025, unless otherwise approved by Miss Kelley. *Please note that not all dancers will make the team, but those with invitations to audition tend to have a better chance. Current competition team dancers' spots are not guaranteed. They still have to audition every year, and there is no guarantee that they will make the team again.

Your dancer must make either Jazz or Tap to make the team, but are required to take both as part of their Team requirements.

Miss Kelley will place all dancers accordingly, based on feedback from their teachers this past season. Dancers who are new to the studio will be placed based on age/dance experience, and may require a one-on-one session to best determine placement.

Dancers who do not make a certain style of dance (ex. Mary makes Jazz, but not Tap) will still be required to take that style as a Recital class in their age level (as part of their requirements) to learn the technique required so they are more capable of making that team style the following year. This is not a parent choice, but a placement made by our KDC Staff. The same rule will apply for all extra styles as well.

New this season- we have added 2 new classes on our schedule this season: Select Large Group Jazz #1 and Select Large Group Jazz #2. These classes will give our dancers the extra confidence and skills required for Jazz, while working with dancers of similar ages/levels in a larger group setting. Dancers will be placed based on their Small Group Jazz audition. While most dancers have the potential to make both small and large group jazz, a few may only make one of these.

Also new this season- we have created Technical Skill sheets for each level of Jazz and Tap. Each student will have to demonstrate these skills, as well as their choreography for their audition.

Dancers who cannot perform/execute the required amount of skills will not make that style.

*Current competition team dancers should be taking advantage of the 2 summer private lesson sessions that we have offered out, to help them to succeed in these skills. New dancers should be taking advantage of the Competition Readiness Program that we offer, as we will work on those skills during that time.

Upon acceptance into the competition team, and for the benefit of the student, the instructors reserve the right to move a student into a different level for Fall classes than originally placed during the Summer Intensive. The age groups listed are only used as a general guide, and therefore, students will be placed into the group that is appropriate for them. The physical and psychological health of a student is always our number one priority. Please remember that Kelley's Dance Craze instructors base their professional assessment and placement of the dancers on their technical strength, ability, work ethic, attitude, and both physical as well as mental maturity. Students will never be placed in a particular group for reasons such as: their friends are in that group, they are older or younger than others in that class, scheduling conveniences for an individual child, etc.

Students demonstrating poor attendance or consistent tardiness may be dismissed from the KDC Competition Team without refund of any kind. This will also be the case for any families who are more than one month behind on their bill.

Students who are struggling or not showing improvement in their technique will require private lessons to keep pace with the rest of the group. *Private lessons are at an additional charge.

KDC Summer Intensive 2025

Cost: discounted flat rate (based on a majority of classes in one level)

Two week program: August 11-14, August 18-21

Starlings: \$160 per student

Sparkling/Rising/Shooting Stars: \$285 per student

Shining/Super Stars/All Stars: \$310 per student

Or \$560 per family (if more than one student in the household is auditioning)

***All classes are run twice: (Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday)**

Sparkling Stars/Rising Stars/Shooting Stars: 10:00 am-1:15 pm

*In some cases, dancers may fall in different levels for different styles, and may have to come in earlier or stay longer for their audition. We may run over in time for each section- we will have your child call if we are running behind. ***All dancers must be present for Team Auditions.**

2025-2026 TEAMS/CLASS REQUIREMENTS

There are 7 KDC Team Levels for the 2025-26 dance season:

Starlings, Sparkling Stars, Rising Stars, Shooting Stars, Shining Stars, Super Stars, and All Stars. *In some cases, groups may be combined for classes.

At KDC, we pride ourselves on having a well rounded team in all styles of dance, so there is not an option to just try out for one style.

- Starlings level dancers will be required to take the 3 main genres of dance: Tap, Jazz, and Ballet, along with a Technique class, and Stretch class.
- Sparkling Stars will be required to take the 3 main genres of dance: Tap, Jazz, and Ballet, along with a Technique class, Conditioning class, Stretch class, and a minimum of one other Competitive class (Hip Hop or Lyrical). *All dancers in Sparkling Stars are also eligible for our Select Large Jazz Group- this will be based on their Jazz audition. Some dancers may make both a small and large group jazz, others may only make the Select Large Group. *This class will be FREE if your child makes both Jazz groups, and included in the cost of your monthly tuition if they only make one.
- All other levels of dancers (Rising-All Stars) will be required to take the 3 main forms of dance: Tap, Jazz, and Ballet, along with a Technique class, a Conditioning class, a Stretch class, and a minimum of two other Competitive Classes (Contemporary, Hip Hop, Lyrical, or Musical Theatre). *All dancers in Rising- All Stars are also eligible for our Select Large Jazz Group- this will be based on their Jazz audition. Some dancers may make both a small and large group jazz, others may only make the Select Large Group. *This class will be FREE if your child makes both Jazz groups, and included in the cost of your monthly tuition if they only make one.
- Dancers are **highly** suggested to take these additional classes for their level (if applicable): Contemporary, Hip Hop, Lyrical, Musical Theatre, Pre-Pointe/Pointe1 (must be 10 or older and be recommended by your ballet teacher), Pointe 2 (must be 11 or older and be recommended by your ballet teacher), Select Large Group Jazz, and any extra classes beyond their requirements. Taking more classes will help your child to become a better, more well-rounded dancer.

- A dancer may fall into more than one level based on their abilities and the genre of dance (ex. Mary is in Sparkling Stars Lyrical and Shooting Stars Jazz.) We never want to force a child on to a team that they are not physically ready for. *In some cases, a class may be combined due to time constraints in the schedule, the number of students, and similar physical abilities.
- Please remember that along with the required classes, any additional classes will also require the purchase of costumes, competition fees (if applicable), and any other costs associated with extra dances, such as shoes, rhinestones, tights, etc.
- The KDC Competition Team will be a group that the entire studio looks up to. They are expected to be on their best behavior at all times, and represent our studio in a positive manner- in person, at events, and on social media.

Discounts and Perks

- **Discount Level 1:** Once a **Starlings level** Competition Team student enrolls in their 5 required classes, **any additional classes will only be \$25 each!** (*This does not include Solos/Duets/Trios, or Private Lessons.)
- **Discount Level 2:** Once a **Sparkling Stars level** Competition Team student enrolls in all of their required classes, **any additional classes will only be \$12.50 each!** (*This does not include Solos/Duets/Trios, or Private Lessons.)
- **Discount Level 3:** Once a **Rising Stars/Shooting Stars/Shining Stars/Super Stars/All Stars level** Competition Team student enrolls in all of their required classes, **any additional classes will be FREE!** (*This does not include Solos/Duets/Trios, or Private Lessons.)

- **Discount Level 4:** There is a cap on tuition for individual students reaching \$305 a month. Any classes beyond this amount are free. (*This does not include Solos/Duets/Trios or Private Lessons.)
- **Discount Level 5:** There is a cap on tuition of \$455 for families (more than one student) who are living in the same household. Any classes beyond this amount are free. (*This does not include Solos/Duets/Trios or Private Lessons.)
- **Solos/Duets/Trios, Private Lessons, Conventions, Competitions, Guest Choreographers, and special in-studio workshops with Guest Teachers are separate charges from the discounts/perks, and will be charged directly to your account.**

Time and Commitment

In addition to regular weekly training, KDC Competition Team dancers, and their parents, are required to commit to the following:

- All new families are required to be present for your individual meeting with Miss Kelley in late August (meeting sign up dates/times will be posted closer to Summer Intensive). Returning families can also request a meeting, but it is not required.
- Be present for the 2025-2026 KDC Competition Team Meeting (September 2, 2025 at 6:00 pm at the studio)
- 2 pre-scheduled mandatory Competition Team rehearsals before competition season begins (January 2026- TBA, February 2026- TBA). These dates will be added to our 2025-2026 calendar online, and will be announced again at our September Meeting (9/2/25).
- 2 pre-scheduled mandatory Finale Rehearsals before Recital (May 2026 TBA, June 2026 TBA). Dates will be added to our 2025-26 calendar online, and will be announced again at our September meeting. Please save the date (9/2/25)!

- 3 pre-scheduled Regional MANDATORY competitions (you must keep these entire weekends open, Fri-Sun), and Nationals every other year (usually an entire week). Every year will also have 1 additional optional Regional competition for Solos/Duets/Trios. Dates will be announced at our early September 2, 2025 (6:00 pm) meeting, but possibly sooner. Please save the date!
- Every year, dancers will be required to attend a pre-scheduled dance convention taking place in the fall- date to be announced by our September 2, 2025 (6:00 pm) meeting, but possibly sooner. Pricing may vary.
- Be present at every competition to support fellow KDC dancers, even if you're not competing on that day. **(*Must be present for at least 3 KDC dances at every competition your child is performing in, other than your own, in a different award ceremony. Most dancers should also try to be present to support their big/little sisters.)**
- Participation in local Wixom events, if applicable. (Dates TBA)
- KDC's Annual Rehearsal and Recital
- Purchase 1 Personal Ad in the KDC Recital Yearbook (any size). *Siblings can share an ad.
- Parent/Guardian volunteer at competitions and recital, signing up to bring food/drinks, helping w/ hair and makeup, costume changes, etc.
- Membership/Participation in our KDC Boosters for all fundraising events.

Costs

- Regular tuition (discounted for Competition Team dancers)
- \$100-\$160 per competition costume (if necessary, costumes exceeding the budget must be approved by all parents in the group) In some cases, the pricing may be less. New this season- half due on October 1st, half due on January 15th.

- \$95.00 per recital costume (Ballet, Finale, Pointe 2, and any additional Recital classes). New this season- due in full on November 1st.
- \$135 per dancer for embroidered warm up Competition Team jacket.
- \$75 makeup kit (if you don't have it already, cost may vary depending on new colors/brands), \$100 for 2 kits (for an additional sibling— these kits include: eyeshadow, blush, lipstick, false lashes, eyelash glue, and earrings).
- \$140 non-refundable commitment fee (or \$185 total for families with siblings on the Competition Team). This fee helps to off-set the cost of teacher compensation at extra rehearsals and competitions, due on September 2nd.
- Entry fees per competition (cost varies by each competition and the amount of dancers in the routines), some competitions also require additional media fees.
- Fees for conventions each year (pricing varies).
- Guest Teaching fee if an outside choreographer is hired on. This fee will be split amongst the number of dancers in the class. *This specifically applies to All Stars Hip Hop this season, due upon 1st Rehearsal with that choreographer.
- Rhinestones, performance tights, and appropriate dance shoes.
