OUR STORY...

THE FOLLOWING IS OUR CHARTER REQUEST MISSION STATEMENT:

OUR PURPOSE IN APPLYING FOR THIS CHARTER IS MORE SO POINTED TOWARDS THE MENTORING NEEDS OF THE LOCAL AREA, SPECIFICALLY SAINT JOHNS, FLAGLER, CLAY, AND PUTNAM COUNTY. A SIZABLE NUMBER OF OMEGA MEN BOTH FINANCIAL AND OTHERS IN NEED OF BEING RECLAIMED LIVE IN THESE COUNTIES AND HAVE ARTICULATED THE IMPORTANCE OF AFFILIATING WITH A LOCAL CHAPTER. SOME THESE SAME BROTHERS HAVE NOT BEEN FINANCIAL FOR MORE THAN THIRTY YEARS. HOWEVER, AS BROTHERS WOULD RANDOMLY MEET OTHER BROTHERS AND BEGIN SHARING THE IDEA OF CHARTERING A NEW CHAPTER, A GREAT DEAL OF INTEREST AND ENTHUSIASM WAS SPARKED. SO, WITH THAT, THERE IS THE REAL POSSIBILITY THAT A LOCAL CHAPTER IN THIS AREA WOULD POSSIBLY HAVE UPWARDS OF FIFTY BROTHERS IN TOTAL INITIALLY AFFILIATED.

ANOTHER ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT REASON WHY A CHAPTER PRESENCE IS NEEDED, THE YOUNG BLACK MEN IN THESE AREAS (AS WELL AS OTHERS) NEED TO HAVE AVAILABLE EXAMPLES OF WHAT POSITIVE BLACK MEN EXHIBIT. WE, AS POSITIVE ROLE MODELS NEED TO BE SEEN AND NOT JUST HEARD OR TALKED ABOUT. EXEMPLIFYING MANHOOD, SCHOLARSHIP, PERSEVERANCE AND UPLIFT ARE NOT JUST PRINCIPLES WE SHARE, BUT STANDARDS OF BEHAVIOR NECESSARY TO LEAD AND TO GUIDE.

EACH BROTHER HAS INDIVIDUALLY BEEN INVOLVED IN THEIR OWN PERSONAL/COMMUNITY OUTREACH ENDEAVORS, BUT AS A GROUP WE HAVE NOT OFFICIALLY ENGAGED IN ANY ORGANIZED ACTIVITIES. ONE HOPE IS THAT WHILE ENGAGING IN THE FRATERNITY'S COMMUNITY ACTION INITIATIVES IN EACH OF THE FOUR COUNTIES WE SERVE, WE WOULD ALSO SEEK OUT ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES WHEN AVAILABLE TO SERVE AND SHOW A PRESENCE. THE SURROUNDING CHAPTERS TO OUR NORTH, WEST AND SOUTH HAVE THEIR AREAS THEY EACH SERVE BUT TRYING TO BE ENGAGED IN THOSE AREAS WOULD PUT AN UNDUE BURDEN AND MISSED OPPORTUNITIES FOR BROTHERS WANTING TO HAVE AN ACTIVE PRESENCE IN THEIR OWN COMMUNITIES. A CHAPTER OF OMEGA PSI PHI FRATERNITY, INC. IF ESTABLISHED HERE LOCALLY WOULD BE A TREMENDOUS ASSET, ABLE TO SERVE AND ULTIMATELY BE THE DIFFERENCE IN THE LIVES OF MANY OF OUR YOUNG BLACK MEN.












DR. DORSEY C MILLER JR. - 2019 KEYNOTE SPEAKER








THE OMEGA MAN OF THE YEAR

THE HISTORY: AS A CHAPTER WE HAD A QUESTION. WHEN WAS THE FIRST OMEGA MAN OF THE YEAR AWARDED AND WHO RECEIVED IT? AFTER EVENTUALLY SPEAKING WITH THE IHQ ARCHIVIST WE WERE DIRECTED TO THE DECEMBER 1939 ORACLE.



ON PAGE 5, WE FOUND A REFERENCE TO "THE NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD". THIS AWARD WAS THE FIRST OF ITS KIND AND WAS AWARDED BY THE ACHIEVEMENT WEEK COMMITTEE TO BRO. WILLIAM H. HASTIE. TODAY THIS AWARD HAS EVOLVED TO BE RENAMED TO THE OMEGA MAN OF THE YEAR.

THE AWARD: THE NOMINEE SHOULD BE A BROTHER WHO HAS MADE SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CHAPTER AND WHO HAS MADE SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS TO HIS COMMUNITY. ADDITIONALLY, THE NOMINEE MUST BE

FINANCIAL ON ALL

LEVELS DURING THE IMMEDIATE YEAR PRIOR TO THE AWARD AND THE YEAR OF THE AWARD. THE EXCEPTION WOULD BE IF HE WERE NOT A MEMBER OF THE FRATERNITY IN THE PRIOR YEAR. SERVICE AND CONTRIBUTION FROM LEADERSHIP POSITIONS ARE A SIGNIFICANT ELEMENT OF THE SELECTION AND SCORING CRITERIA FOR THE OMEGA MAN OF THE YEAR AWARDS.

A (NEW) IMN TRADITION: IN HONORING THE AWARD'S HISTORY AND NOTABLY THE EXAMPLE SET BY THE FIRST OMEGA MAN OF THE YEAR, WE WANTED TO HONOR OUR CHAPTER NOMINEE WITH SOMETHING TRULY SPECIAL. WE FELT OUR CHAPTER AWARD NEEDED TO REPRESENT THE HISTORY AND THE PRESTIGE ASSOCIATED WITH THE AWARD.

ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

THE ACHIEVEMENT WEEK committee, headed by Brother Campbell C. Johnson, has just announced that Brother William H. Hastie has been nominated for the National Achievement Award for 1939.

The nominee is well known to all of us, so it is not necessary to go into the merits of your choice. Judge William H. Hastie is a graduate of Amherst College, Phi Beta Kappa; Harvard University School of Law; formerly assistant solicitor, Interior Department; and until recently was judge of the District Court of the United States for the Virgin Islands, becoming the first Negro Federal Judge in the history of our country.

Judge Hastic resigned this post recently to accept the deanship of the School of Law, Howard University.

Because of his outstanding achievement in becoming the first Negro Federal Judge of our country and for serving in that capacity with conscicuous ability, the Achievement Committee has nominated him for our first national award.

The award will be presented to Dean Hastie in person at the Conclave, following which he will deliver the annual address to the fraternity. We congratulate Brother Hastie, and hope he will meet with the same success in his new work as he did on the Federal Bench.



OUR FIRST OMEGA MAN OF THE YEAR



WILLIAM HENRY HASTIE, JR. (NOVEMBER 17, 1904 – APRIL 14, 1976) WAS AN AMERICAN, LAWYER, JUDGE, EDUCATOR, PUBLIC OFFICIAL, AND ADVOCATE FOR THE CIVIL RIGHTS OF AFRICAN AMERICANS. HE WAS THE FIRST AFRICAN AMERICAN TO SERVE AS GOVERNOR OF THE UNITED STATES VIRGIN ISLANDS, AS A FEDERAL JUDGE, AND AS A FEDERAL APPELLATE JUDGE.

EARLY LIFE

HASTIE WAS BORN IN KNOXVILLE, TENNESSEE, THE SON OF WILLIAM HENRY HASTIE, SR. AND ROBERTA CHILDS. HIS MATERNAL ANCESTORS WERE OF AFRICAN-AMERICAN AND NATIVE AMERICAN HERITAGE, AND FAMILY TRADITION MENTIONED THAT ONE FEMALE ANCESTOR WAS A MALAGASY PRINCESS. AFTER HIS GRADUATION FROM DUNBAR HIGH SCHOOL, HASTIE GRADUATED FIRST IN HIS

CLASS, MAGNA CUM LAUDE FROM AMHERST COLLEGE IN MASSACHUSETTS. HE RECEIVED A LL.B. FROM HARVARD LAW SCHOOL IN 1930, FOLLOWED BY A S.J.D. FROM HARVARD LAW SCHOOL IN 1933.

LEGAL CAREER

HE WAS IN PRIVATE PRACTICE OF LAW IN WASHINGTON, DC FROM 1930 TO 1933. FROM 1933 TO 1937 HE SERVED AS ASSISTANT SOLICITOR FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, ADVISING THE AGENCY ON RACIAL ISSUES. IN 1937, PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT APPOINTED HASTIE TO THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE VIRGIN ISLANDS, MAKING HASTIE THE FIRST AFRICAN-AMERICAN FEDERAL JUDGE. THIS WAS A CONTROVERSIAL MOVE: SENATOR WILLIAM H. KING OF UTAH, THE CHAIRMAN OF THE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE CALLED HASTIE'S APPOINTMENT A "BLUNDER."

HASTIE SERVED AS A JUDGE FOR TWO YEARS. IN 1939, HE RESIGNED FROM THE COURT TO BECOME THE DEAN OF THE HOWARD UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF LAW, WHERE HE HAD PREVIOUSLY TAUGHT. DURING HIS TENURE AS A LEGAL PROFESSOR AT HOWARD UNIVERSITY, HASTIE BECAME A MEMBER OF OMEGA PSI PHI FRATERNITY. ONE OF HIS STUDENTS THERE WAS FUTURE SUPREME COURT JUSTICE THURGOOD MARSHALL. HE WAS A CO-LEAD LAWYER WITH THURGOOD MARSHALL IN THE VOTING RIGHTS CASE OF *SMITH V. ALLWRIGHT*, 321 U.S. 649 (1944). IN 1939 THE OMEGA PSI PHI FRATERNITY NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT WEEK COMMITTEE NOMINATED HIM FOR THE FIRST "NATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD", RECOGNIZED NOW AS "THE OMEGA MAN OF THE YEAR". THE AWARD WAS PRESENTED THE FOLLOWING YEAR AT THE NATIONAL CONCLAVE WHERE HE DELIVERED THE ANNUAL ADDRESS TO THE FRATERNITY.

WORLD WAR II

DURING WORLD WAR II, HASTIE WORKED AS A CIVILIAN AIDE TO THE SECRETARY OF WAR HENRY STIMSON FROM 1940 TO 1942. HE VIGOROUSLY ADVOCATED THE EQUAL TREATMENT OF AFRICAN AMERICANS IN THE ARMY AND THEIR UNRESTRICTED USE IN THE WAR EFFORT. ON JANUARY 15, 1943, HASTIE RESIGNED HIS POSITION IN PROTEST AGAINST RACIALLY SEGREGATED TRAINING FACILITIES IN THE ARMY AIR FORCE, INADEQUATE TRAINING FOR AFRICAN-AMERICAN PILOTS. AND THE UNEQUAL DISTRIBUTION OF ASSIGNMENTS BETWEEN WHITES AND NON-




WHITES. THAT SAME YEAR, HE RECEIVED THE SPINGARN MEDAL FROM THE NAACP, BOTH FOR HIS LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENTS AND IN RECOGNITION OF THIS PROTEST ACTION.

THIS WAS EXPECTED TO BE THE END OF HIS GOVERNMENT CAREER. BUT IN 1946, PRESIDENT TRUMAN APPOINTED HASTIE TERRITORIAL GOVERNOR OF THE U. S. VIRGIN ISLANDS—THE FIRST AFRICAN-AMERICAN TO HOLD THIS POSITION. HASTIE SERVED AS GOVERNOR FROM 1946 TO 1949.

FEDERAL APPELLATE JUDGE

HASTIE RECEIVED A RECESS APPOINTMENT TO THE U.S. COURT OF APPEALS FOR THE THIRD CIRCUIT FROM HARRY S. TRUMAN ON OCTOBER 21, 1949 — THE FIRST AFRICAN-AMERICAN APPELLATE JUDGE. HASTIE WAS CONFIRMED BY THE UNITED STATES SENATE ON JULY 19, 1950, AND RECEIVED HIS COMMISSION ON JULY 22, 1950, GOING ON TO SERVE ON THE APPELLATE COURT FOR 22 YEARS.

AS THE FIRST AND MOST DISTINGUISHED AFRICAN-AMERICAN ON THE FEDERAL BENCH, HASTIE WAS CONSIDERED AS A POSSIBLE CANDIDATE TO BE THE FIRST AFRICAN-AMERICAN



JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT. IN AN INTERVIEW WITH ROBERT PENN WARREN FOR THE BOOK WHO SPEAKS FOR THE NEGRO?, HASTIE COMMENTED THAT, AS A JUDGE, HE HAD NOT BEEN ABLE TO BE "OUT IN THE HUSTINGS, AND TO PERSONALLY SAMPLE GRASSROOTS REACTION," BUT THAT, IN ORDER FOR THE CIVIL RIGHTS MOVEMENT TO SUCCEED, CLASS AND RACE MUST BOTH BE CONSIDERED.

IN 1962, PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY CONSIDERED APPOINTING HASTIE TO SUCCEED RETIRING JUSTICE CHARLES WHITTAKER. BUT POLITICAL CALCULATIONS PREVENTED KENNEDY FROM MAKING THE APPOINTMENT. ON THE ONE HAND, AN AFRICAN-AMERICAN APPOINTEE WOULD HAVE FACED FIERCE OPPOSITION IN THE SENATE FROM SOUTHERNERS SUCH AS JAMES EASTLAND (D-MISSISSIPPI), CHAIRMAN OF THE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE. ON THE OTHER HAND, ON ISSUES OTHER THAN CIVIL RIGHTS, HASTIE WAS CONSIDERED RELATIVELY CONSERVATIVE, AND CHIEF JUSTICE EARL WARREN REPORTEDLY OPINED THAT HASTIE WOULD BE TOO CONSERVATIVE AS A JUSTICE. KENNEDY APPOINTED BYRON WHITE INSTEAD.

KENNEDY REMARKED THAT HE EXPECTED TO MAKE SEVERAL MORE APPOINTMENTS TO THE COURT IN HIS PRESIDENCY AND THAT HE INTENDED TO APPOINT HASTIE TO THE COURT AT A LATER DATE.



IN 1968, HASTIE BECAME CHIEF JUDGE OF THE THIRD CIRCUIT. AFTER ONLY THREE YEARS, HE STEPPED DOWN AS CHIEF JUDGE, AND ASSUMED SENIOR STATUS ON MAY 31, 1971. HASTIE DIED IN PHILADELPHIA WHILE PLAYING GOLF ON APRIL 14, 1976. THE THIRD CIRCUIT LIBRARY IN PHILADELPHIA IS NAMED IN HIS HONOR. IN ADDITION, AN URBAN NATURAL AREA IN KNOXVILLE, TN IS NAMED IN HIS HONOR.







Agency continues toy giveaway

The Palatka Housing Authority made sure its residents were feeling the holiday spirit by providing them more than 150 Christmas gifts Monday. The organization, in collaboration with the Rotary Club of Palatka and the Iota Mu Nu Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, hosted its seventh annual toy giveaway.

"This giveaway is synonymous with the spirit of giving and the spirit of Christmas," Palatka Housing Authority President Anthony Woods said. According to Woods, the giveaway gets bigger each year. He said the Palatka Housing Authority had enough presents this year to give to entire families.

"Oftentimes, we find that the older kids find themselves left out because most of the gifts are intended for younger children," Woods said. "We've been trying to spread the gifts further throughout each family. That has proven to be very effective."

According to Aaron Robinson, Palatka Housing Authority director of social services, the organization's staff selected which families would receive the gifts.

"We try to make sure we don't duplicate and don't give to the same families we have in previous years," Robinson said. "Our staff - for example, our custodial staff - they know the stories of the families who live here and know them well because they've actually been inside these people's homes." Throughout the day, families stopped by the Palatka Housing Authority Office to pick up their gifts. In cases where the family couldn't go to the office, staff members went to their houses to deliver the presents.

"A family we came across recently has a child who is suffering from brain cancer," Robinson said. "That's one example of a family that could really use these gifts but can't be here today due to a medical appointment. We'll make sure they get their gifts though." Housing authority residents weren't the only people who received gifts. The housing authority also gave gifts to 42 kids who live at the Lee Conley House, a local domestic violence shelter.

"We seek out organizations that are doing similar community service projects," Omega Psi Phi member Will Jones said. "We look to partner with them and wanted to make sure we gave gifts to the Palatka Housing Authority as well as the Lee Conley House." The Palatka Housing Authority also plans to provide a free dinner to its tenants on Christmas. The Christmas dinner will be hosted at the Lee Conlee House, and the time has yet to be determined.
