2022-2023 PROGRAM & SERVICE RESULTS

Transition Out of School and Out of the Home

Transition Into Community and into Community Groups

We had **1/1** person successfully transition from a 1:1 home based program, into a 2:1 Clubhouse program. **100**%

We had **2/2** persons successfully transition from a 1:1 programs, into a 3:1 program. **100**%

Transition into a Community HUB and into Volunteer Work

4 Transition into a Workpalce

We had **3/3** persons successfully transition from a 1:1-3:1 programs, into a 6:1 program. **100%**

We had **6/9** persons successfully transition into a workplace and meet work expectations. **66%**

Transition into a Work Hub and on to a Work Team

Transition into a Job with a Supervisor after 6 months

We had **10/11** persons successfully transition into a workplace and meet work expectations. **90%**

We had **7/8** persons successfully transition into a workplace and meet work expectations. **87.5**%

Transition into a Supported Living Arrangement


8 Transition to a New Position

We were able to demonstrate the effectiveness of our Transition into supported Living program by decreasing the cost of care by 80%

We were able to meet the transition needs of 17/20 persons 85%, with a typical cost of \$50,000 per person a transition. That is 58% of the cost expected.





Having the essential skills for your job is important. Take part in higher education or an On-the-Job Training Program to get the skills you need.






Coordinate Learning
