We at UYA will be in strict compliance with all rules and regulations of the Federal Aviation Administration with flying an aircraft in U.S. airspaces. All youth aviators will be instructed and will follow all necessary FAA regulations while at United Youth Aviators Programs. All Aviators **MUST BE ON TIME** on the day of their scheduled flight to be on time to the Airport. Those that miss the shuttle will not fly that day and will not acquire logged flight time.
