STUBBLE VALUE

Dean Thomas's Modern Stubble Value project showed how feed value varied between components and crops. Stem and leaf material from barley stubbles was approximately 1MJ/kg higher in energy compared with wheat. Fine stem, leaf and pod material from lupins had the highest ME content of the different crops.

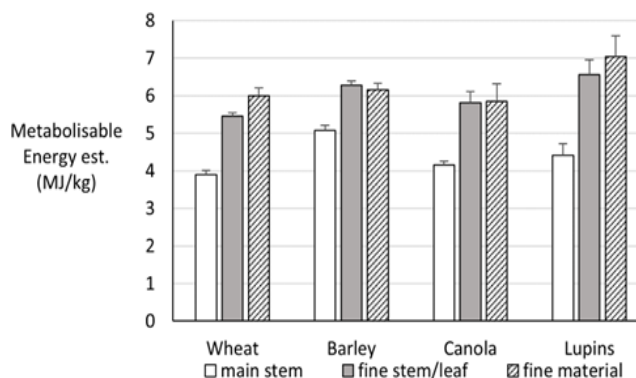


Figure 4. The estimated metabolisable energy content (MJ/kg DM) of chaff collected from winter crop stubbles in Western Australia (2018)
