EXIT STRATEGY FOR A LATE BREAK

We've had some positive seasons over the previous few years. With pastures available early due to summer/autumn rainfall. The 2023 break to the season has yet to happen for some areas across the state. With pasture limited and many producers currently feeding out hay and grain to livestock.

Creating a plan to help reduce stress caused by limited feed, is a great way to deal with this situation and help everyone sleep better at night. This plan is called an "Exit Strategy" and is a clear plan of how to manage stocking rates and carrying capacity, within the constraints of a season. Methods within this plan include: Reduce feed demands e.g sell dry ewes/wethers Bulking up pastures by sowing fast growing cereals, such as oats
Buying more feed in
Deferring pastures

ORAL LICE DRENCH


Registration of an oral lice treatment in Australia has recently happened. The product, now available in the Australian market, controls isoxaoline susceptible lice (Bovicola ovis). This includes resistant strains to synthetic pyrethroids and insect growth regulators on sheep and lambs with any wool length. There is a 54 day ESI on the product to reduce the risk on exported sheep meat.
