## **VITAMIN E TIME**

For most of you, its been at least 6 weeks since your sheep have seen green feed. Time to give them some Vit E, especially the weaners. A few ways to do this is:


- -Drench if they're near yards
- -Water additive (WSD vit E is the product, also has Selenium)
- -Licks
- -Mixed in/spray on feed- Eg Rovimix E50. Put it out over 2 feeds! Trail feeding is best so all animals can get access.

2.5g of powder/head. Mix into the feed cart as filling it. Same if use a liquid, spray it in or onto a trail. If mixing with water to spray on, rate is 5kg for 10L of water. For a 50% active, 5kg=2000 sheep. How much grain to mix this with-your normal ration. A simple way is to go back to the 2.5g/hd and multiply it by the number of sheep the feeder is feeding.
