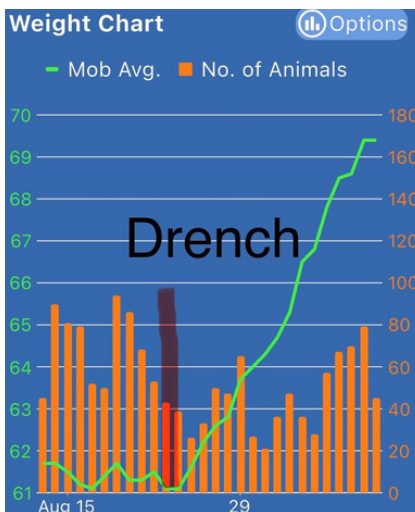

01 Worms

Keep an eye on your worm burden this spring! Some areas have had and are continuing to have a long the growing season this year. This is increasing the number of worm cycles and our potential worm burden. This image from an Optiweigh demonstrates the impact. This combined with increasing market prices for both meat and wool as well as flystrike risk makes it a no brainer.



02 Weaners

Make summer easier for yourself by setting lambs up from weaning: right weight, right growth trajectory. If you haven't already weaned, you should (if they average 14 weeks old). From 8 weeks old, most of a lamb's diet is pasture, so you're impacting the ewe for no proven gain. How heavy are your lambs? If you can, weigh a sample and use this to create your rations and plan a growth rate. No matter their weight, they need 70% dry matter and 14% protein.

REMINDER- Funding Open for Live Sheep Export Phase Out

Round 1 of the Supply Chain Capacity Program is now open. Producers can apply for grants of up to \$2 million towards finishing and feedlotting developments. To be eligible, applicants must demonstrate matching co-contributions. Applications close 22 October 2025.

Unfortunately any costs incurred prior to a project commencement date set as part of a grant agreement (for successful applicants) cannot be funded. As a rough guide, the grant agreements for successful applicants will be finalised in January 2026, with projects being able to commence around Feb/March 2026.
