Our Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Foundation started on September 29th, 1899 in Columbus, Ohio, where the 'American Veterans of Foreign Service' organized as a National body. The VFW Foundation is to serve veterans, service members, and their families by securing resources for programs that facilitate enhanced outcomes. Our Mission is to foster camaraderie among United States veterans of overseas conflict and to serve our veterans, the military, and our communities. Our Motto is: "No one does more for veterans!" Our Post, including our Auxiliary and our Cooties, does a fantastic job supporting our veterans, their families, and our community by visiting veterans at the local Veteran Center and nursing homes and assisting homeless brothers and sisters! Additionally, we are reaching out to our fellow Veterans Service Organizations, such as our Disabled American Veterans and American Legion brothers and sisters enhancing resources for our veterans.

Our Post has been doing an incredible job with our membership drive – as of Friday, the 22nd of March, we have 1,432 members and 1,300 of them are Life Members. We have surpassed the National Commanders goal of 102% and are currently standing 104.37%. At our VFW State Conference in Erlanger on the 15th and 16th our very own Quartermaster, Mrs. Belinda Gather-Schmidt, was recognized by the Department (State Level) as the Number One Recruiter in the state with 46 new and returning members. Way to go Belinda; keep up the great work!

We have also added an additional official Post Recruiter, Sergeant First Class (SFC) Jason Graham; he is still on Active Duty and will be leading our membership drive on Fort Knox. We will be sending out dates on Facebook and our texting platforms looking for volunteers to support Jason on Fort Knox in the near future!
