Team 10281, this will be my last monthly Newsletter. We have accomplished so very much this year! We made a bunch of facility upgrades to our Post; supported so many events within our community, high schools, and JROTC programs. We added the Fort Knox Army Recruiting and Retention College as a unit that our VFW supports, helped homeless Veterans with meals and put them up in hotels out of the weather. We put on a new roof, upgraded HVAC units, and painted the kitchen.

We supported the Joint Executive Counsel of Veterans Organizations (JECVO), provided critical relief supplies to flood victims in Kentucky; cleaned up headstones at our Veterans cemetery, we honored our POW/MIAs, and held Post ceremonies. Some of our Legends passed away and we conducted funeral ceremonies as requested by their families. We had the Saint Patrick Day River Dancers entertain us. Now we have added the "Two Man Band" and scheduled comedians to come for our entertainment. We had the best year at the Turkey Shoot surpassing several records from the past. We got snowed out and flooded out. We coordinated with our fellow Veterans' Organizations: such as the American Legion, Disabled American Veterans (DAV), the new Elks Club, the Combat Veterans Motorcycle Association (CVMA), and our other motorcycle groups. We received great support from our Scout Troop 152, the Fort Knox Bluegrass Challenge Academy, and JROTC from our schools. And so many more activities supporting our communities, Army Base, our members and our Veterans!

We had our "VFW Day of Service" and wonderful First Responder "Loyalty Day" with seven city and county Police, Sheriff, and Firefighter groups - with over 55 in attendance for their annual Honor Ceremony. They had a great meal and enjoyed the fellowship with other first responders and our veterans!

We achieved all this while we grew our membership to more than 1,518 members surpassing the VFW National Commander's goal of 102% to currently over 104%, making "All State" for the second year, and currently in fifth place at "All American."

I cannot thank you enough for the long volunteer hours you have dedicated to out Post, its members, and our community. Our volunteers are the very best! A big thank you to our past Commanders and past Auxiliary Presidents for their mentorship and patience throughout the year.

It has been my honor serving as your Post Commander over the last two years; you have a **Great** Command Team coming in as Commander Andrell "Jack" Jackson and his team transition at the State Convention in Lexington, KY from June 12-14<sup>th</sup>.


