- We are now at 112 members!
- Since our last meeting...
 - Town Hall Decorating
 - \$4k gross profits
 - Sold even more wreaths than last year
 - Saved 30% on cost of raw materials by buying wreaths through Market Basket
 - Fast set-up: Next year we may not need to set up so early
 - Small swags made from leftover greens: Surprise success
 - Bake sale: Accounted for ~1/3 of our proceeds
 - Holiday Luncheon
 - 65 members attended, 75 people total including guests
 - Buffet lunch was delicious and cost-efficient
 - Raffle: "Teams" made impressive baskets resulting in 60% increase in raffle profits
 - Toy Drive: Another huge success. Thank you to our generous members!
