REQUIRED GEAR

Mandatory for all participants, shooters, and staff

SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- ANSI-rated eye protection (clear or tinted)
- Ear protection (electronic preferred)
- Individual First Aid Kit (IFAK) with tourniquet
- Closed-toe footwear (boots or duty shoes)
- Water source (hydration pack or canteen)
- Range-appropriate attire (long sleeves recommended)

FIREARMS & AMMUNITION

- Primary rifle (WWII-era or modern equivalent, see optional list)
- Secondary pistol (if desired; 9mm or .45 ACP acceptable)
- 4 magazines per weapon system (minimum)
- Magazine pouches or load-bearing gear

Ammo Provided by Event:

- 5.56mm / .223 Remington
- .30 Carbine
- Bring your own ammo if shooting:
 - o .45 ACP
 - o 9mm
 - o Any specialty calibers (e.g., .300 BLK, 6.5 CM, etc.)

Note: Suppressors are permitted during zeroing and warm-up, but must be removed before competition stages to maintain historical authenticity.

RECOMMENDED GEAR

For performance, safety, and comfort

- Shooting gloves
- Dump pouch
- Range belt or chest rig
- Sun protection (hat, sunscreen)
- Weather-appropriate clothing (layers, windbreaker)
- Notebook & pen
- Multitool or weapon-specific tools
- Minimal cleaning/lube kit

● THEMATIC / OPTIONAL ENHANCEMENTS

For immersive WWII atmosphere—encouraged but optional

UNIFORMS / APPAREL

- WWII USMC P41 utilities or repro uniforms
- HBT coveralls or OD green BDU equivalents
- M1 helmet (reproduction acceptable)
- WWII-style boots or "boondockers"
- Cartridge belts, canteens, suspenders (USMC-style)

HISTORICAL FIREARMS (or approved modern substitutes)

- M1 Garand (.30-06)
- M1 Carbine (.30 Carbine)
- M1903 Springfield (for long range)
- Thompson SMG (.45 ACP)
- M1911 pistol (.45 ACP)
- BAR (approved use only)
- Themed opposing force rifles allowed if cleared by staff (e.g., Arisaka)

OTHER PERIOD TOUCHES

- Replica dog tags
- Unit insignia or Iwo Jima patches
- Commemorative flags
- Themed haversacks, ammo bags, or gear

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Armor-piercing, steel-core, or tracer ammunition
- Unsafe or untested reloads
- Intoxication or substance use
- Non-compliant or unsafe equipment (subject to RSO inspection)

✓ FINAL NOTES

- All gear and weapons will be safety-checked by RSOs during check-in.
- Chamber flags **not required**.
- Ammo issued based on registered weapon platform (unless BYO caliber).
- Suppressors allowed for zero/warm-up only—remove before scoring runs.
- Limited loaner gear and themed clothing available upon request.
