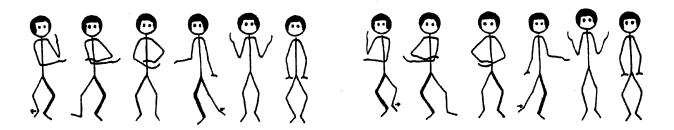
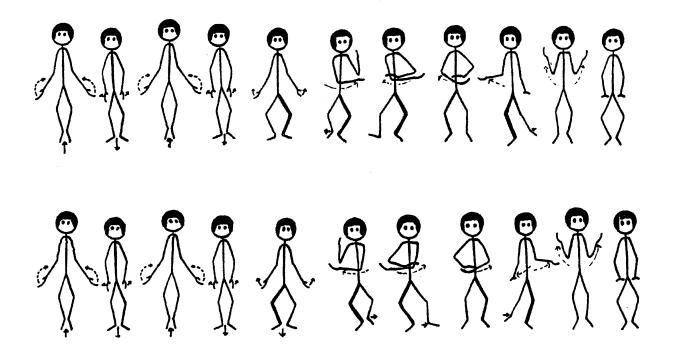

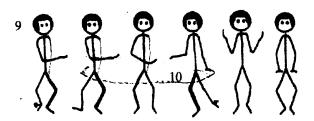

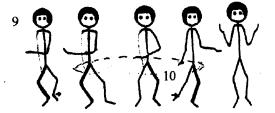

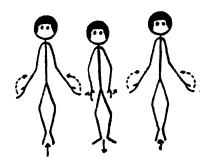

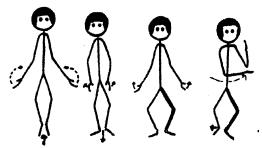




11. Wrist Circles: Wrist Circle Taffy Style



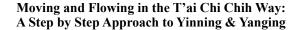
12. Third Wrist Circle & Spiraling down: Wrist Circle Taffy Style
