The Sage Does Nothing...

One of my favorite quotes from Justin Stone in Spiritual Odyssey is, "Overtly the Sage do nothing, and thereby all things are accomplished." It is in the essay, "The Essence of T'ai Chih." Every month I start a new Beginner I class, and I always share this essay as part of lesson for the class. Something in me completely relaxes when I read that sentence. I love

continual reminder every month that "I" am not the doer. There is a vital loving intelligen Force that flows through everyone and everything. T'ai Chi Chih is incredibly powerful in ability to help us wake up to this flow and surrender to its movement in our practice and ultimately in our lives. When we do, the feeling is one of effortless effort, right action, naturalness, ease, lightness and joy. I feel this is how we are all meant to live.

Our egos by nature feel cut off or separate from this flow. Without this connection we fe is all up to us. "We" are the doer. This can feel like a heavy responsibility, and we move through life with effort and force leading to much tension and stress. When students britthis same mindset to T'ai Chi Chih we see the tension and effort in their movements. The movements originate from their shoulders and upper arms blocking their connection and of the Chi. What a gift to see them slowly let go of this doing and find their inner source the Chi through their feet and Tan T'ien. Over time trust in this inner source grows deepe deeper and as it does, they are able to surrender the doer more and more.

I have heard the statement that it takes a lot of effort to get to effortlessness and there some truth to that. It reminds me of Justin Stone's words:

Trying is not the Way

Not trying is not the Way

You say it must be one or the other,

But I sayNeither Nor

For me the effort lies in the continual choosing to align with this loving intelligent Life For moment by moment. It is what brings us to our classes and our practice. T'ai Chi Chih and Chi will do the rest. We can relax and trust the journey.

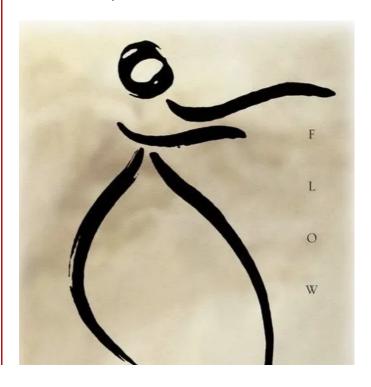
