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Who Is The Westlund Center?

The Westlund Center (TWC) was established in 2022 through the philanthropic efforts of Laura Westlund (1943-2023), a longtime resident of Kirkland, WA. Laura created a 501 (c)(3) Private Charitable Trust to ensure the sustainability of a mental health service to a university-centered community.

After an examination of need, California State University at Northridge (CSUN) and its 30,000-plus student population were selected as the focus of her gift.

Cost

Clinical services for enrolled students at CSUN are provided **free of charge**. This is in keeping with the Trust's mandate.

Approach

Guided by an analytical framework, our Tele-Mental Health Service incorporates ethical best practices in providing long-term individual psychotherapy to enrolled CSUN students referred by a campus-based mental health service.

Services

TWC's tele-mental health service program will be staffed by trained and supervised MSW graduates registered as Associate Clinical Social Workers completing the required supervised clinical hours for licensed clinical social work application status in California.

Expectations

As part of the referral process, several initial sessions may be devoted to both parties identifying need and fit to establish a working alliance framework.
