Legislative Update

Well #TXLEGE23 is alive and well. With Committee Hearings starting up in both the House and Senate. With bills already passing out of committees.

At the last GOP meeting we were still awaiting Speaker Phelan's committee assignments, and low and behold he announced them the very next day. Here is the link to the House committee's:

Please note: We were able to diminish the number of Democrat Committee Chairs from 13 to 8. Thank you to all who made phone calls, sent postcards, sent emails, and showed up to the Opening Week of session in your *No Dem Chair* shirts. We will not change the way Austin runs overnight, but we are on the path to making change.

Please note that 2 special committee's have formed, and they need to be duly noted.

The House Committee on Youth Health & Safety, Select. Chair is Rep. Senfronia Thompson (Democrat). This is the committee that any transgender bills will go through.

The House Committee on Community Safety, Select. Chair Rep Ryan Guillen (Republican).

This committee will focus on matters related to the possession, use, sale, and transfer of all firearms and ammunition, as well as any associated criminal offenses and penalties.

Governor Abbott also declared his Legislative Priorities:

- 1. Cutting property taxes.
- 2. Ending COVID restrictions forever.
- 3. Education freedom for all Texans.
- 4. School safety
- 5. Ending "revolving door" bail
- 6. Securing the border
- 7. Fighting fentanyl crisis

Just in case you did not hear Speaker Phelan has been releasing his Legislative Priorities as well. Due to the Legislative Priorities being released nearly every other day, feel free to reach out if you would like to know what they are. Let's just say they are far from the GOP priorities and not even close to Governor Abbott's priorities.

When I say, "That no Legislative Session ever runs the same as the year before," believe me. This one is truly a differing entity from the past 2 sessions. Be fluid, for the Legislative Session is a crazy roller coaster and ever changing ride.

With all that said, committee hearings are taking place, public comment is being

made, bills are being passed out of committees, and bills are still being filed.



Pandora's Box: HB 23

I believe most of us are familiar with the Pandora's Box myth, and the way the phrase is used today in colloquialism. Once the box is open, there is no telling what is going to come out, and how can we stuff it back in once it is out? Or, can we even attempt to put anything back in the box, and are we to live with the consequences of the box running amuck? I think we all noticed the transgender issues being brought to a head over the past 3 or 4 years. In my time as a high school coach, I was seeing this trend in women's sports over 10 years ago, and it is one of the major reasons I decided I could not be a part of that world anymore. I never understood how female to male and male to female athletes were able to get around that rule as I was always referred back to Title IX. At any rate, female sports must be protected. Maybe we can stuff some of the depravity back into Pandora's Box.




