

### **2017 Grant Recipients**

**Hopeful Horizons:** Hopeful Horizons are our major grant recipient this year. The Wexford Foundation grant of \$100,000 enabled this outstanding children's advocacy, domestic violence and rape crisis center to open a new satellite office in Bluffton to provide safety, hope and healing to victims of child abuse, violence and sexual assault in southern Beaufort County.

Boys & Girls Club of Hilton Head Island (BGCHHI): Their mission is to enable young people to reach their full potential as productive, caring and responsible citizens. Their afterschool program reaches over 200 students per day and this grant will fund new computers for their computer lab.

The Children's Center: The Children's Center provides a quality preschool and daycare learning environment for the working poor in our community. This grant will fund materials for children in Kindergarten through third grade, and also provide support for field trips.

**Family Promise:** Family Promise's mission is to provide temporary shelter, family stability and permanent housing solutions for homeless families with children. This grant will provide funds for participants in its Leaping Forward and Staying on Track Program.

**Heather Trew Foundation:** The Heather Trew Foundation is dedicated to raising awareness of the importance of organ, eye and tissue donation. This grant will provide much needed equipment and educational materials.

Heroes of the Lowcountry: The Heroes of the Lowcountry provides help to underserved students in Beaufort and Jasper Counties so they can realize their dream of continuing education beyond high school. This grant will provide money for an expanded scholarship program for 2017-2018.

**Hilton Head Island Safe Harbour:** Hilton Head Island Safe Harbour provides transportation, and other services to allow our aging population to remain in their homes. This grant will help them to recruit additional volunteer drivers to reduce the waiting time for their services.

Hospice Care of the Lowcountry: Hospice Care of the Lowcountry gives comfort, honor and dignity for end of life patients and their families through compassionate physical, emotional and spiritual care. This grant will provide funds to their Veterans Caregiver Relief program to provide nursing assistance to terminally ill veterans.

The Literacy Center (TLC): TLC's primary mission is to equip adults with reading, writing, math and speaking skills that are needed to be self-reliant and successful at home, work and in the community. This grant will fund their Family Literacy Program to develop literacy skills for children with their parents.

**Meals on Wheels:** Meals on Wheels provides a hot, mid-day meal 5 days per week to those in need of nutritional help. This grant will enable them to serve 6 new clients for one year

**National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI):** NAMI is dedicated to improving the lives of individuals with mental illness and their families. This fund will cover speaker fees, travel, staff time, hospital outreach and training programs to improve services for patients and families of the mentally ill.

**Neighborhood Outreach Connection:** Provides tutoring, health screening, and workforce development for students and families living in poverty. This grant will enable them to purchase equipment for students use and for adults to learn English.

**Pockets Full of Sunshine:** Pockets Full of Sunshine's mission is to make Beaufort County a 'sunnier' place by employing intellectually and physically disabled adults. This grant will fund the purchase of much needed supplies for arts and crafts made by special needs adults.

**Programs for Exceptional People (PEP):** PEP's goal is to enhance the lives of adults with disabilities by providing socialization, occupational and employment opportunities. This grant will enable PEP to bring in more adults each day and return them safely to their destination.

**Second Helpings:** Second Helpings work with Food Providers and Distributors to distribute food and eliminate hunger to those in need in the Lowcountry. This year's grant will help fund transportation to improve their delivery service.
