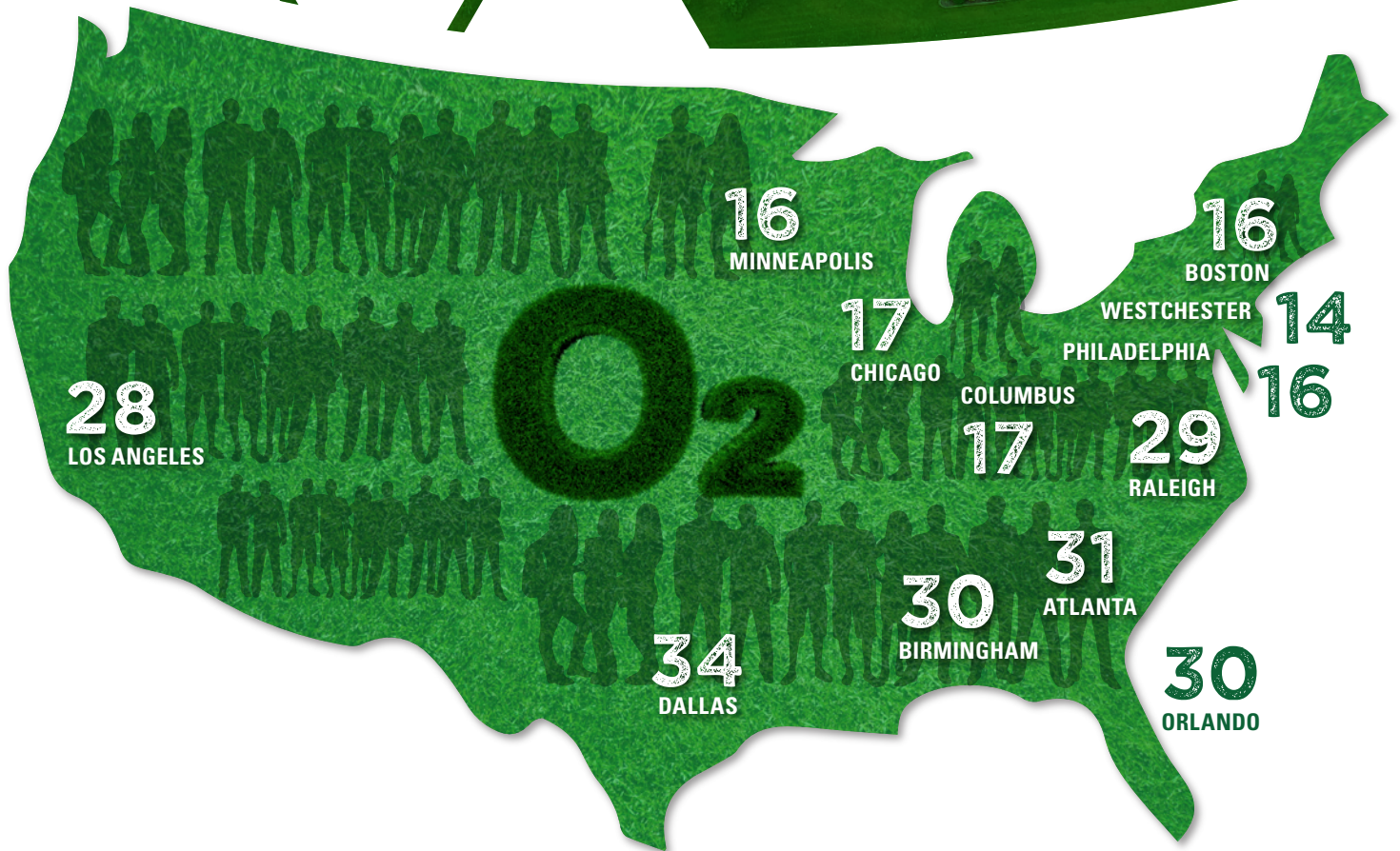


Fresh Oxygen Production by Natural Grass Lawns in the United States



One 5,000 square feet grass lawn can produce enough oxygen each day to support 14 to 34 people, depending on location.

It's no secret that plants produce oxygen but did you know that researchers can actually model how much? University faculty at an internationally recognized plant physiology research program have been working to determine how much fresh oxygen is produced by natural grass lawns in the United States.
