Minutes of 8/11/2025 business meeting; Kay made motion to approve, Jim 2nd

ROAD REPORT [Scott Warner]

- Kay and Jim signed ODOT Local Maintenance Detour Route Post-Detour Release Forms for ODOT #ASD-42-14.77 PID 114065. One form signed for detours involving closure of U.S. 42 and a 2nd one involved with closure of State Route 302 just east of U.S. Route 42 to just East of State Route 89.
- Resident Michael Welch requested mowing on Twp Rd 351.
- Culvert on 101 scheduled for repair this month.
- Discussion on patch: Should avoid purchasing virgin material at a cost of \$7 more than standard.
- Injectors were repaired on the 550.

ZONING REPORT [Rick Wikucki]

- Michael Donatini is going to review proposed changes to zoning resolution. Victor Dubina will get a version for review that shows what the actual revisions are.
- Couple of new house permits given out in Cinnamon Lake.
- Burkholder property on CR 700 still has empty trailers. Will check with Prosecutor to determine options for getting all trailers off property within a set number of days.
- Jim made resolution #2025-5 to move forward and purchase an updated Ashland County Highway Map from County Engineer Ed Meixner. Kay in agreement.

FIRE DEPARTMENT [Trustee Scott Markley: Not present]

- Nothing to report.

CEMETERY [Trustee Kay Wright]

- Roadcrew will do the repair on 3 stones that have slid off their base.
- Michael Conley will be cremated at a cost of \$795 in Cleveland – hospital certified that he was indigent. Jim made 2025-6 to pay the cremation for Michael Conley at a cost of \$795; Kay in agreement.

FINANCIAL REPORT [Fiscal Officer Cheryl Welch]

- Receipts between 8/12/2025 and 9/8/2025 totaled \$94,116.64 (2nd half property taxes received)
- Expenses totaled \$50,076.39.
- Fund balances totaled \$346,167.95 (Primary account is \$244,291.91)
- \$95,000 or 28% of the fund balance is money from ARPA earmarked for Spectrum internet project.
- Jim made motion to accept the financial report; Kay 2nd

PARK [Trustee Jim Power]

- Port-A-Johns will be picked up anytime now – they leave after Labor Day.

OLD BUSINESS

- No update on Spectrum.
- Mr. Nelson from Ashland RR has put a couple of shovels of hot patch on 89 and 175 crossings: crossing in Jackson Township will be reviewed for full repair in 2026. Crossing on 89 will be reviewed for repair in later part of 2025.

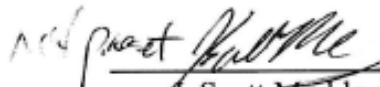

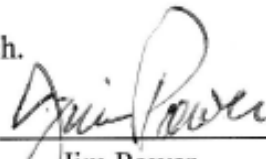

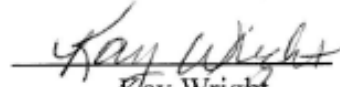
PUBLIC PARTICIPATION
