ROAD REPORT [Scott Warner]

- · 810 and 902 are to be chip and sealed.
- US Route 42 will be closed to thru traffic for 60 days; board is aware of the detour route.
- As of August 1st, state route 89 has been reopened.

ZONING REPORT [Rick Wikucki]

- · Case with Carl Way has been filed; court date is yet to be assigned.
- Hearing on 1.8 acre lot on 620, where a home burnt down, new owners want to put up a house. Minimum
 acreage for a home is 2.
- · Hearing: Conditional use permit on windows and screens on 101.
- Hearing: Potential business for alpaca hair and crafts at 208 CR 620.

FIRE DEPARTMENT [Trustee Scott Markley]

- · 8 fires, 36 squad calls, \$255,000 loss to Jackson Township was a house in Cinnamon Lake.
- · New squad delivery was delayed.

CEMETERY [Trustee Kay Wright]

· Wants Scott and James to push fallen stones back onto the base and apply glue.

FINANCIAL REPORT [Fiscal Officer Cheryl Welch]

- Receipts between 7/13/2024 and 8/12/2024 totaled \$101,065.19 (receipts include: 2nd half of property taxes and 100% reimbursement for BJAAM environmental clean-up work).
- Expenses totaled \$88,419.50.
- Fund balances totaled \$386,779.07 (Primary account is \$289,957.46)
- \$96,821.61 or 24% of the fund balance is money from ARPA earmarked for Spectrum internet project.
- Jim made motion to accept the financial report; Scott 2^{nd.}
- The \$1,000 MORE grant money was received to cover road sign expenses.
- Meeting with county auditor resulted in: (1) reduced LGF projection from \$25,000 to \$21,000 and (2) recommendation that board consider levying \$5 motor vehicle license tax pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4504.18 on every licensed vehicle.

PARK [Trustee Jim Power]

- · Some ball traveling teams have been using the ballfield for practice.
- Security cameras will be installed to identify and prosecute illegal dumping activity.

OLD BUSINESS

- Corner of 251 and 620 guardrail is in bad shape. Before repairs can be made the culvert is going to be evaluated. Ed Meixner is going to be consulted.
- · Building improvements should be completed by month end.
- Board discussed electrical aggregation program. Historically, Palmer did have better rates. Kay made motion to cede back to the county program (Palmer Energy) by end of the year, Jim 2nd; Scott in agreement.
