

December 13, 2021

Regular Meeting was called to order by Scott Markley.

Present were Fiscal Officer Cheryl Welch, Trustees Kay Wright, Scott Markley, Jim Power.

Zoning Inspector: Rick Wikucki (Not present) Road Workers: Not present.

Minutes of 11/8/2021 business meeting approved– Kay motioned to accept; Jim 2nd; Scott in agreement.

ROAD REPORT

- In Cinnamon Lake there are beavers building dams in the culverts on 251; there is currently a man trapping them.
- Board gave Robert Turk written permission to clean-up the township right-of-way on TR 351.

ZONING REPORT (Rick Wikucki – Not present)

FIRE DEPARTMENT Trustee Scott Markley Nothing to report.

CEMETERY Trustee Kay Wright

- Robert & Patty Turk purchased 12 cemetery plots in the amount of \$4,275
- Resident Galaska donated a flag which could possibly be used for cemetery.

FINANCIAL REPORT Fiscal Officer Cheryl Welch

- Receipts between 11/8/2021 and 12/13/2021 totaled \$16,497.70 Expenses totaled \$17,252.56. Fund balances totaled \$324,962.14 (Primary account is \$133,956.)
- \$191,005.39 or 59% of the fund balance is money from ARPA.
- Jim made motion to accept the financial report; Kay 2nd. Scott in agreement.
- Cheryl ran the numbers on the ARPA Revenue Replacement Calculator and the township revenue without the pandemic would have been \$304,953; actual revenue was \$391,816. This calculation was done for the specific purpose of determining if the ARPA funds could be used to replace lost revenue in the general fund – it cannot.

NEW BUSINESS

- 2022 Organizational meeting will be 6:30pm on January 10th with regular business meeting to follow.

OLD BUSINESS

- Kay confirmed that safety signs were purchased from Judco in the amount of \$757.80. Cheryl will pay invoice before end of year and apply the \$500 MORE grant toward these expenses; thus costing the township \$257.80.


PARK Trustee Jim Power

- Park dumpster will be locked up at the end of December. Overgrown brush along driveway that Cheryl brought to Jim's attention will be taken care of by end of December.


PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

- Resident Howell asked that building permits be posted for viewing.


Kay made motion to adjourn, Jim 2nd: Scott in agreement. Meeting minutes submitted by Cheryl Welch.
