## **SSG Jonathan Campbell**

Jonathan grew up in Russell, PA, and graduated from the University of Pittsburgh at Bradford in 2008 with Business Management and Economics degrees. He began working at Northwest Bank and is now a Small Business Lending Underwriter. Jonathan joined the National Guard in 2011, enlisting as an 11B Infantryman. While in Basic Training, he also earned an 11C Indirect Fire Infantryman MOS. He married his wife in 2013 and is the father of three beautiful, spunky girls.

Jonathan spent 12 years with C Company 1-112 INF Regiment based in Lewis Run, PA, and in 2022 transferred to Bravo Company, 1-112 INF in Cambridge Springs, PA. When he transferred to B Company, he took on the role of Unit Public Affairs Representative, where he regularly submits photos to the Public Affairs Office for the PA National Guard, highlighting the training and helping to tell the story of the Guard and his unit. Most recently, Jonathan deployed to Kenya in the Horn of Africa region in 2024 with B Company as part of a security force mission.

Jonathan graduated from the Army's Advanced Leader's Course in his military career and earned the Air Assault Badge. He also earned 3 Army Achievement Medals, an Army Commendation Medal, and several other state awards.
