

Affordable Connectivity Program

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The **Affordable Connectivity Program IACPI** provides eligible households \$30 per month off their internet bills. ACP-eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers.

Eligibility

A household is eligible for ACP if at least one of the below criteria are met:

1. The household income is at or below 200% of Federal Poverty Guidelines

The table below reflects the income limit by household size, which is 200% of the 2022 Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Household Size	Pennsylvania
1	\$27,180
2	\$36,620
3	\$46,060
4	\$55,500
5	\$64,940
6	\$74,380
7	\$83,820
8	\$93,620
For each additional person, add:	\$9,440

**You may have to show proof of income, like a tax return or three consecutive pay stubs, when you apply for the ACP.*

2. A member of the household meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income internet program

3. A member of the household participates in one of the following federal assistance programs:

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- Medicaid
- Housing Choice Voucher
- Public Housing
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants, and Children (WIC)
- Veterans Pension or Survivor Benefits
- Free and Reduced-Price School Lunch and School Breakfast Program
- Lifeline

NOTE: You may need to show a card, letter, or official document as **proof that you participate** in one of these programs when you apply for the ACP.

4. A member of the household received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year.

The ACP is limited to one monthly service discount and one device discount per household.

How to Enroll?

The enrollment process requires two steps.

1. Go to AIToidableConnectivity.gov to apply online or print out a mail-in application.
2. Contact the preferred participating provider to select a plan and have the discount applied to the bill. Please note that some providers may have alternate application that they will ask you to complete.

Eligible households must both apply for the program and contact a participating provider to select a service plan.
