- Functions as the employer of record.



Microboard Benefits:

- Performs on-going reporting and accounting.
- Provides consistency and safety for the person receiving services.
- Connects a person receiving services to a larger network.
- Ensures reliability of caregivers and responsible use of resources.

Individual Benefits:

- Provides the person a voice in planning and decision-making.
- Surrounds the person with a stable circle of supporters for their whole life.
- Provides a way to make connections to have a full life, enhancing what family members can offer.
- Reduces the risk that a family emergency will create a crisis for the person.
