FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (the Commission) at a public meeting on November 4, 2021, in St. Augustine, Florida. It was alleged by Administrative Complaint that the Respondent had violated specified sections of Chapter 943, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 11B-27, Florida Administrative Code. The facts were not contested and, at the Respondent's election, the hearing was conducted in accordance with the provisions of §§ 120.569 and 120.57(2), Florida Statutes. The Respondent was duly notified of the hearing but neither appeared nor was represented at the proceedings.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The allegations of fact set forth in the Administrative Complaint are supported by competent substantial evidence. Those allegations of fact are approved, adopted and incorporated herein by reference as the Commission's findings of fact.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Commission has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this case.

2. Under §943.1395, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 11B-27, Florida Administrative Code, the allegations of fact set forth in the Administrative Complaint constitute good legal grounds for taking disciplinary action against the Respondent.

It is therefore ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The Respondent will be on five (5) day prospective suspension to be served within 180 days following the filing of this Final Order; one (1) year probation beginning at the conclusion of the suspension period. The Respondent must comply with the following terms of probation:

- I. The Respondent shall refrain from violating federal, state and local laws. If during the period of probation the Respondent violates any part of Chapter 943, Florida Statutes, or Title 11B, Florida Administrative Code, and is later found at a formal or informal hearing (conducted within or beyond the probationary period) to have committed such a violation, then the Commission will revoke all of the Respondent's criminal justice certification and eligibility for certification.
- II. The Respondent must make himself available to answer any questions and produce any documents requested by the Commission or its staff during his probationary period.
- III. The Respondent must provide Commission staff with proof of successful completion of a staff or Commission approved substance abuse counseling prior to the end of the probationary period.

2. This Final Order will become effective upon filing with the Clerk of the Department of Law Enforcement.


