

Before using the Wrappon Trekker WT-4

Thank you for purchasing Wrappon Trekker WT-4, auto-wrapping (tear-and-seal) portable toilet. This User's Manual explains how to correctly handle Wrappon Trekker WT-4 as well as simple explanation and maintenance procedures. Please read this User's Manual thoroughly before using Wrappon Trekker WT-4 for safe use.

Product Overview

- Wrappon Trekker WT-4 is an auto-wrapping portable toilet designed for hygienic features. It also designs for elderly and handicapped persons and handicapped persons who have walking difficulties. But, please do not use for other purposes.
- Wrappon Trekker WT-4 is a clean, simple and odorless toilet that uses special coagulant and wraps the waste automatically.
- Wrappon Trekker3 cannot be wrapped by itself alone. The designated film roll must be used.
- The film roll is sold separately.
- When assembling the product, be careful not to get your fingers caught in the main unit.
- For any questions on how to use the Wrappon Trekker WT-4, contact the company you purchased.



Before using the product, read the "To Ensure Safe Use" section thoroughly to ensure correct use. The precautions described here represent important safety-related issues and must be observed.

Warnings



PROHIBITED

Be careful not to damage the cords, plugs, etc.

Do not damage, do not modify, keep away from high temperature, do not forcibly bend, do not twist, do not pull, do not place under a heavy object, or do not bundle them.

- A damaged cord or plugs, if used, may cause electric shock, short circuit, or fire.
- When unplugging, hold the plug itself and pull out straight.
- If the power supply cord becomes damaged, ask the seller to repair it.



PROHIBITED

When the main power supply is ON, do not put your hand in the film or toilet.

The rollers or seal bar may trap your hand causing severe injury.



PROHIBITED

Do not insert hand into the opening area from the bottom of the product.

Inside the product, there are moving parts which may damage and burn your hands.



DO NOT **DISASSEMBLE**

Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the product.

High voltages are present inside the product, which may cause electric shock, fire, or product malfunctioning result in injury.



PROHIBITED

Use the product only as a toilet and do not use for other purposes.

- Do not place inside a vehicle and use it as a seat.
- Do not use the product as a
- Do not use the product as a pallet.
- Do not use the product as a chair while taking the toilet seat off.

The above may cause the product to topple or be damaged, causing injury.

MUST BE OBSERVED

Regularly clean the dust off from the power supply plug.

Accumulated dust may cause an insulation failure, resulting in fire due to overheating. Disconnect the power supply plug.

MUST BE OBSERVED

If you hear thunder, do not touch the main unit or power supply plug.

May cause electric shock.



PROHIBITED

Do not place a heavy load on the product.

- Do not stand on the product.
- Do not move the product while person is on the product.
- Do not use two persons at the same time.

UNPLUG

Before maintenance or inspection, disconnect the power supply plug.

If not unplugged, you may get an electric shock or an injury.

To Ensure Safe Use (continued)

Warnings



✓ NO OPEN FLAME

- Do not install the product near an open flame.
- Do not throw flammable material or lit cigarettes into the toilet.

Deform the product may cause short circuit or fire which may result in waste leakage.

Do not use the product near a stove.

PROHIBITED

Children or adults who require assistance in moving must not use the product by themselves.

- May result in injury if mischief movement is done by a child.
- May result in falling down of the product.

PROHIBITED

Do not use the person heavier than 150kg.

It might be damaged and may result in injury.



MUST BE OBSERVED

Do not put the coagulant into your mouth.

The coagulant is not food. Check the precautions for use.

MUST BE OBSERVED

The product must be used on a flat and stable location.

If installed in an unstable location, the product may fall down and cause injury.

UNPLUG


If the product is not to use for a long time, disconnect the power supply plug from the electrical outlet.

Insulation deterioration may cause electric shock or fire.



MUST BE OBSERVED

Before use, make sure that you check if the film roll is



cause the product failure.



PROHIBITED

Do not throw large quantity of toilet paper into the toilet.

When wrapping the film, the toilet paper may get tangled with the film, resulting bad seal with a leakage.



PROHIBITED

Do not install, use and store at the following places.

- Lots of dust and dirt.
- Places such as bathroom over 80% humidity.
- Locations exposed to rain and direct sun light.

If you install, use and store the product in these places, you may get the trouble.

Caution



PROHIBITED

Do not put in more than the specified amount of coagulant.

The coagulant may become trapped between the rollers which may cause the product to fail.

For the coagulant information, please refer the coagulant note on use.



PROHIBITED

Do not use anything except the designated coagulant.

Using any other coagulant may cause insufficient coagulation, clogging, wrapping failure, or product failure.

MUST BE OBSERVED

The user must sit squarely on the toilet seat.

If the user sits close to the front edge, the waste may leak and cause the product to fail.



MUST BE OBSERVED

Throw used toilet paper into the middle of the toilet.

If not observed, it may cause clogging and wrapping failures.



PROHIBITED

Do not press the push button while seated on the toilet.

The film will get caught in the toilet seat, causing product failure or wrapping failure.



PROHIBITED

Use the product only if wrapped film does not remain on the bottom cover.

If wrapped film remains, it may cause product failure or wrapping failure.



MUST BE OBSERVED

When installing the film roll, the power supply cord must be disconnected.

If not observed, it may cause clogging and wrapping failures.



PROHIBITED

Do not use other film roll than designated film roll.

Using other film roll may cause it to get trapped inside the product, and may cause waste leakage or product failure.



MUST BE OBSERVED

Install the toilet seat to the body properly.


Wrong installation may cause the product fall or product malfunction. This may result in product failure.



MUST BE OBSERVED

Make sure that you press the "Yellow" button for initializing after installing a new film roll.

If you do not run the initial film-bonding operation, the waste may leak, causing the product to fail as the film is not sealed.




To Ensure Safe Use (continued)





MUST BE OBSERVED

Push down the film installation jig while aligning it with the protrusions on the top plate.



If the product is used without a film installation jig, film may be dislocated from rollers and unbalanced film feeding which may cause the wrapping failure.



PROHIBITED

To clean the product, use a diluted solution of mild kitchen detergent. Do not use any of the following: toilet cleaner, benzene, solvent, or cleanser.

Using such a prohibited product may damage the product, causing injury. It may also cause product deformation or discoloration.



PROHIBITED

Do not stack up more than five units.

Products may fall over and may be broken resulting injury.



PROHIBITED

Do not relocate the product while connecting the power source plug.

You may trip on the cord resulting the disconnection of the plug or short circuit.



PROHIBITED

Do not move without wrapping.

Waste may leak. The floor and the product is soiled. So make sure that you move the product after completing the wrap cycle.



MUST BE OBSERVED

Do not place the product on the uneven floor.

The product may get broken.



MUST BE OBSERVED


Reinforcement bar must be installed.


Without it, the product may fall resulting injury.




Top view with the toilet seat removed




Assembling the Main Body


- Read 'Ensure the safe use' on page 4~8 before assembling.
- Check 'Parts and accessories list' on page 9 to make sure all are available.
- · Use outlet with a ground terminal to plug in.
- Place the product with the bottom.



Remove the bottom cover by unlockin the two locks.




Pull up the both legs and connect the both AC adapter cord.




- *The back side is the side with handle.

- ② After connecting, fixing the plug cord.


Pull and place the cords of AC adapter Cover up and the Remote Control Unit through the backside.


Installing a film roll

- Before installing a film roll, check 'assembling the main unit' on P11.
- · While the plug is on, do not insert your hand inside the toilet.
- To function wrapping mechanism properly, a film roll must be installed properly.
- Do not use other than the designated film roll.
- Make sure that the power supply is disconnected from the outlet.


Remove the toilet seat and inside cover.



Unlock two clips and remove the film guide at upward.



Install a film roll along with film guide.


Watch out the film position and arrow direction.

Install the film guide which you took at 2.




Push it until you hear the click sounds.

Remove Clamping bands at four locations of the film roll.




- Take the film cassette cover out.
 - 1 Lift up the uppermost edge of the film roll from the upper end of the film guide by approximately 30cm.



- 2 Grip the upper portion of the film roll in a lump.
- 3 Push the lump in the toilet as far as you can.





Installing a film roll (continued)

Push down the film installation jig while aligning it with the protrusions on the top plate.


The correct form of the film installation jig should be below in circle.











Pull up the film installation jig.
Check if the film is properly set or not.




Film must be sandwiched both left & right set of rollers.




Film is sandwiched with one set of rollers.

Put the power plug into an outlet. Make sure that the power light is green.



When you push the flush button, the initial bonding starts.
While wrapping, condition light flashes green.


Without this, the bottom of the bag is not sealed.



Wrapping takes about 90 seconds. Display screen shows an estimated time remaining to complete the wrapping (approximately 90 seconds countdown) When completed wrapping, you hear beep sounds.

Condition light of remote control is off.


After condition light is off, take out the separated film.
This completes film setup.



When you see the 'STOP' mark in the film (Changing the film roll)


- Change the film roll immediately.

 If you continue using the film, the film roll is running out, resulting a cause of waste leak.

- Take out the toilet seat and insaide cover.



After removing the toilet seat and the inside cover, press film feed button(blue).

By holding down the film feed button, the film is sent out for about 20cm. You keep pulling the film roll below gently until the film is running out. If you did not pull the film, it may cause the film wrappedaround the rollers.



Pull the electric power cord from the Outlet.

Install a film roll.

Refer to the process(2-11) of 'Installing a film roll' on page 13.

How to use the toilet

- •Before using, make sure that the plug is connected to electric power outlet.
- •Do not insert hand into the toilet.
- ·Sit down on the toilet as Western-style toilet.
- •Do not stand and urinate. You should sit down on the toilet and urinate.
- ·Wrapping cycle takes about 90 seconds.
- •When finished, you can hear the sound of beep, beep, beep. Then, the condition light turns to green.
- Do not throw cigarette and sharp-edged items in the toilet. You can throw human waste, wet tissue and sanitary goods.
- · If you drop something in the middle of wrapping, wait until the cycle finishes. Then, you open the wrapped film and take it out.
- •There is a possibility of waste leaking as the wrapped film is not 100% sealed due to the environment and condition. Also make sure that you use the coagulant and the tray.

★ Check before use ★

- Make sure that operation light of remote control is off.
- Make sure that you check if the film roll is installed. If the STOP mark is appeared on the film, replace it with a new film roll(refer P15).
- Check if there is no damage to the part of toilet seat that touches the body.
 If there is a damage, please do not use it.
- Rour one packet of special coagulant. Before you do defecation, make sure that you pour the coagulant.



Relief yourself.
Sit on the soft toilet seat in the correct position.


Push down the toilet paper so it is not sandwiched with press bar.

When finished, stand up and press and hold the operation button on the remote control for one second.

Make sure that you are away from the toilet seat.

After about 90 seconds, you hear Beep sounds. The wrapped film is automatically cut.

Do not start the next cycle until the film is completely cut off.



After checking that the condition light is green, pull the bottom cover out.


Disposal of wrapped waste film must follow the local government.



Selector swich of input power supply


Wrappon Trekker(WT-4) can use AC adapter(accessory), battery (sold separately) and DC cable for car (sold separately) as an input power supply.

If the input power supply and selector switch do not matchi, it detects voltage of input power supply which may result in unusable. So,please make sure that you select proper swichi against input power supply.




Input Power Supply

When you use AC adapter (accessory) and the dedicated battery(sold separately), please set the selector swich to the DC cable for car.



When you use the dedicated DC cable for car, please set to the dedicated DC cable(sold separately) to the side of the selector switch as shown below.



Maintaining the Product

Maintaining the product regularly to ensure hygienic use over a long period.

- •Before performing maintenance or inspection, disconnect the power supply plug.
- •Regularly dust the power supply cord.
- ·Keep the product clean.
- •When cleaning, never use toilet cleaner, benzene, solvent or cleanser.
- ·After you finish cleaning, reinstall the soft toilet seat.

Daily maintenance

- For light soiling, wipe with a wet soft cloth lightly.
- For heavy soiling, wipe with a soft cloth soaked with diluted mild kitchen detergent.

Inside toilet is soiled


If the inside toilet is contaminated with human waste, do not insert hand into toilet. Stop the operation immediately. Pull off the power cord from power source. Please call the shop or the distributor.



Installing the film roll

When you change a film roll, it is recommended to wipe the back side of soft toilet seat and the top plate. Wash with soft cloth soaked with diluted mild kitchen detergent. After that, wipe with water.

Inside cover is consumable. Purchase a new one if it is soiled or broken.



Storing the product

- Before storing the product, clean the toilet seat and other parts by referring 'Maintaining the product'.
- When the product is not used immediately, disconnect the power supply plug from the electric power outlet.
- If wrapped film remains on the bottom cover, remove and discard it.
- If wrapped film is stored for a long time with waste inside, odor and smell occur. Earlier disposal of the wrapped film is recommended.


About the storage environment

An ideal storage location is an indoor with temperature between $0^{\circ}\text{C}\sim40^{\circ}\text{C}$ with low humidity.



Do not use the location as listed below.

- ·Dusty location
- ·Locations such as bath room where the humidity exceeds 80%.
- ·Locations exposed to rain or direct sunlight.



Frequesntly asked questions

Question	Answer
Will the wrapped waste really not emit odor even if left as is.	If wrapped film is stored for a long time, wrapped waste in the bonded area may deteriorate and cause odor leakage. So, dispose it without delay.
Do I have to wash the tray every time?	It should not become soiled because waste is wrapped after each use. Should the tray become soiled, wash it with water.
Isn't replacing the film roll difficult?	The film roll is designed to change without difficulty. Just follow the film roll replacement section in this manual or quick reference.
Can I dispose of the wrapped waste as combustible waste?	Like disposable diapers, wrapped waste is treated as combustible waste. However,, because the specific rules vary among individual local governments so check with your local government.
How should I clean the product?	Gently wipe with a soft cloth soaked with diluted mild kitchen detergent and rinse with a damp cloth dipped in water and rung out. The unit contains a heater for wrapping the film. Therefore, never pour or spray water on the unit when cleaning the unit. Otherwise, the heater may malfunction.
Why do I have to use the wet tissue?	If light paper such as toilet paper is used, it may become trapped during the wrapping operation and cause waste leakage. Therefore, use only designated flushable wet tissue.
Is it OK to flush waste that has been coagulated with paper coagulate down a regular flushing toilet?	Yes, the volume that can be flushed at one time is about one cup(200CC). So, you may have to flush the coagulated waste in several times.
Is it OK to flush waste that has been coagulated with the polymer coagulated down a regular toilet?	No. Because the polymer is water-insoluble, do not flush it down a regular flushing toilet.

About the display window and condition lights on the remote control unit.

Display when the toilet is bging used.

Display	Status	Explanation
green PWR OPE ERR	Ready	Power supply light is green.
After relieving, press and hold	the flush button	of remote control unit for one second.
green PWR OPE ERR green flash	Wrapping	Operating light flashes green. The approximate remaining time to complete wrapping will be displayed on the display screen. Please wait for while as it is wrapping. *Wrapping takes approxmately 90 seconds.
green PWR OPE ERR	Ready	The operating light goes off and beep sounds are heard. After taking out the wrapped film from the bottom cover you can use the toilet again.

Display when re-wrapping

Display	Status	Explanation
green PWR OPE ERR green flash	Re-Wrapping	When the operation is interrupted for some reason while wrapping, wrapping motion will be resumed after the power is turned on again. Power light up in green and operation light flashes green.
green PWR OPE ERR	Ready	Wrapping is completed when the operation light is turned off and beep sounds heard. Remove the wrapped film, then you can use it again.

Economic mode and standby mode

Display	Status	Explanation
green flash	Standby	After one minute and five minutes, it becomes an economic mode as the power light flashes. Then, if you do not use more than 60 minutes, the power is turned off automatically. To restart, you push any button, then the power is on and after initaial operation, it can be used again.


Display	Status	Explanation
Press the operation button		
green PWR OPE ERR green flash	machine is in operation	Operation light flashes green. Estimated remaining time to complete the wrapping process is displayed on the display screen. So, please wait for a moment. *Wrapping takes approximately 90 seconds.
green PWR OPE ERR	Ready	Wrapping is completed when the operation light is turned off and beep sounds are heard. Remove the wrapped film, then you can use it again.

When the error occurs

Display	Check the following	Countermeasures
Flashing depending on the condition. PWR OPE ERR	Displayed error codes are E.22, E.23 and E.24.	⇒ Buzzer sounds. Remove the foreign articles near the saaled area and push the operation button.

ë		Did you forget to pour the polymer coagulant in?	This product does not seal completely. Depending on the operating condition and condition such as wrong film setting, the waste inside the film may leak so make sure you pour polymer coagulant. After that, refer to "Correct re-wrapping" on Page 26.

	Waste is not wrapped correctly.	Has the film come off the rollers?	⇒ Follow the steps ⑦, ⑧ under 'Installing the film roll' on page 14, use the installation jig to insert the film between the rollers.

Re-wrapping


- 1 Open the film that has been incorrectly wrapped.
- 2 Firstly, pour a scoopful of coagulant. Then, put the film of 1.
- 3 Press and hold the flush button of remote control unit for one second.
 - If Wrappon Trekker WT-4 becomes soiled with waste, refer to 'Maintaining the Product' on page 19.
 - Should the waste get on your hand, wash it thoroughly with water and disinfecting soap, and then, disinfect with alcohol.
