Relocation is required for these in-person roles, with relocation assistance provided by Google. Salary varies based on experience, role, and job location. Sources like [Glassdoor](#) share potential salary ranges, but keep in mind that the posted numbers are based on user submissions and may not be accurate.

New hires must be available to relocate and start work within 1 month of hire. These roles are ideal for new graduates or students who have the option to complete their degree remotely while employed. If you are a current student, work with your college to confirm that this option is available to you.

Minimum Qualifications

Data Center Technician:

- Experience in troubleshooting hardware or network-related issues using Linux-based tools
- Experience in a data center or network operation center environment

Data Center Facilities Technician:

- Associates degree, trade school certification, or equivalent practical experience
- 2 years of experience at Apprenticeship/Technician level in Mechanical/Heating, HVAC, and/or Electrical Engineering
- Ability to lift and move 50 lbs. of equipment and work on platforms, ladders and under raised floors
- Ability to work non-standard hours and differing work rotations/shifts
