2. Do you or any of your family members have allergies to dogs? Do you know that NO DOG is 100% hypoallergenic and we can not guarantee a dog to be 100% hypoallergenic?

3. Do you acknowledge that a puppy is a lifelong commitment?

4. Do you agree that if you are ever unable to keep your puppy for any reason or life circumstance you will contact us and NEVER PLACE YOUR DOG IN A SHELTER OR RESCUE? We will always take our puppies back.....no matter the reason and assist in finding them a new home.

5. Do you realize that your puppy will require consistent grooming? *(A shorter haircut will be less maintenance at home, but your puppy will need to be put on a regular grooming schedule with a groomer as soon as vaccinations are complete. This helps continue teaching them to accept and behave for the grooming process. We begin grooming them at 3-4 weeks of age to introduce them to the process but they need to continue this education after going home to prevent them from developing bad habits or fears that cause them to become difficult for a groomer to groom)*

6. Do you realize that you will need to brush your puppy regularly at home to prevent their coat from matting? (We

will gladly show you the proper method of brushing and what brushes and combs to use if you do not know)

7. Do you acknowledge that you understand that deposits are non refundable? The only time deposits are refundable is if the puppy you have chosen does not pass it's health exam at our vet prior to going home.
