


SHRUBS	SPECIES AVAILABLE	SUN	BLOOM	CHARACTERISTICS
	<b>Purple Rock Clematis</b> (Clematis Occidentalis)	Shade— part Shade	Blue	Bell-shaped flower, Climbs trees, Short-lived, self sows
	<b>Water Willow</b> (Decodon Verticillatus)	Shade	Pink	Lake edges, Shrub-like Plant, Shallows and lakeshores
	<b>Thimbleberry</b> (Rubus Paviflorus)	Sun- Shade	White	Blooms May –August; Red berries valuable to wildlife
	<b>Meadowsweet</b> (Spiraea alba)	Sun— Part Sun	White	Fragrant; bark and roots source of aspirin, shoreline stabilizer
	<b>Steeplebush</b> (Spiraea Tomentosa)	Sun— Part Sun	Pink	Good landscape plant; shoreline stabilizer
	<b>Pasture Rose</b> (Rosa Carolina)	Sun— Part Sun	Pink	Red hips; Dry, loamy soil conditions
	<b>Virgin's Bower</b> (Clematis Virginiana)	Sun— Part Sun	White	Starry-white flowers followed by silky-plumed seed heads; deer resistant




GRASSES & WILDFLOWERS	SPECIES AVAILABLE	LIGHT	FLOWER	HABITAT	CHARACTERISTICS
	<b>Tall Beardtongue</b> (Penstemon digitalis)	Sun-Part Sun	White	Mesic	36-48" attracts pollinators; blooms May-July
	<b>White sage</b> (Artemisia Ludoviciana)	Sun-Part Sun	White	Dry-mesic	12-36" fragrant; leaves used for tea; blooms July-Oct.
	<b>Wild Bergamot</b> (Monarda fistulosa)	Sun-Part Sun	Purple	Dry-mesic	24-36" dense flower head, attracts hummingbirds & butterflies; blooms May-Sept.
	<b>Switch Grass</b> (Panicum virgatum)	Sun-Part Sun	NA—grass	Mesic	36-48" clump lacy sprays, airy seed heads, attracts birds.
	<b>Wild Strawberry</b> (Fragaria Virginiana)	Sun-Shade	White	Dry mesic	6" open groundcover for sunny, dry areas
	<b>Giant Sunflower</b> (Helianthus Giganteus)	Sun-Part Sun	Yellow	Mesic; Wet-land	8' long blooming, Abundant flowers, Deer resistant
	<b>Wild Petunia</b> (Ruella Humilis)	Sun	Purple	Dry-Mesic	12", a favorite of pollinators

	<b>Black Eyed Susan</b> (Rudbeckia hirta)	Sun-Part Sun	Yellow	Mesic	1-2' attracts birds & pollinators; blooms June-Oct.
	<b>Cardinal Flower</b> (Lobelia cardinalis)	Sun-Part Shade	Red	Wet-land; Moist Mesic	36-48" showy red flower spike. Hummingbirds & butterflies; blooms June-Oct.
	<b>Dotted Mint</b> (Monarda punctata)	Dry to Mesic	White/lavender	Dry to Mesic	2' pollinators; can be used for tea; blooms May-Aug.
	<b>Fox Sedge</b> (Carex vulpinoidea)	Sun-Part Sun	NA—grass	Wet-land	12-36" colonizer of distributed ground
	<b>Wild Columbine</b> (Aquilegia Canadensis)	Sun-Shade	Red/Gold	Wood-land	1-2', hummingbirds, deer resistant, blooms in May-June
	<b>Harebell</b> (Campanula rotundifolia)	Sun-Part Sun	Lavender	Mesic	12" delicate bellshaped flowers thin grassy stems, shade tolerant, hummingbirds; bloom Jun-Sept.
	<b>Lance-Leaf Coreopsis</b> (Coreopsis lanceolata)	Sun	Yellow	Mesic	24-36" bright yellow notched ray flowers; bloom Jun-Aug.
	<b>Little Bluestem</b> (Andropogon scoparius)	Sun-Part Sun	NA—grass	Mesic	36" amber foliage year round; ornamental grass.
	<b>New England Aster</b> (Symphyotrichum novae angliae)	Sun-Part Sun	Purple	Dry-Moist	24-36" orange yellow center, attracts pollinators; blooms Aug—Oct.
