



Would you like to grow your own fruit and vegetables, but lack the garden space?

Do you like spending time outdoors and want a pastime that rewards your efforts?

Then why not rent an allotment!

Longcroft Allotment Association (LAA) is a volunteer-led organisation created to support and promote allotments in this area. We have two secure sites – one with over sixty plots on Brockwood Lane (Digswell Site) and a second smaller site on Corals Mead, off Broadwater Crescent (Broadwater Site).

The Association is run by a small committee of members working on behalf of plotholders. Most of our funding comes from membership rents and subscriptions. Joining the Association means becoming part of a mutual support group promoting interest and enjoyment in growing fruit, vegetables and flowers.

Benefits include access to the LAA shop located on the Digswell site (open monthly on Saturday mornings, from March to October), which sells a selection of horticultural essentials, such as compost, farmyard manure, netting, slug pellets, etc. at competitive prices compared with other outlets.

Throughout the year members receive four newsletters plus email updates. And an annual discounted seed scheme is available through King's Seeds.

Come and meet some new people and make new friends! Allotments are a place to unwind, relax and take time out from a hectic lifestyle. They can be an enjoyable family activity or an opportunity for reflective solitude.

Currently each site has a short waiting list, less than a year, for plots between 2.5 and 7 poles (a pole is about 25m²). Plot rents are only around £11 per pole per year.
