Gary Miller is Executive Director Emeritus of the Penn State World Campus. He began his career in educational media at Penn State in 1968 and has worked with media from television to satellite to online learning. From 1986 to 1993 he was Executive Director of the International University Consortium for Telecommunications in Learning at the University of Maryland University College. In 1994, he returned to Penn State as Assistant Vice President for Distance Education, eventually serving as Associate Vice President for Outreach and Executive Director of Continuing and Distance Education. In 2004 he was inducted into the International Adult and Continuing Education Hall of Fame. He received the 2009 Prize of Excellence from the International Council for Open and Distance Education for lifelong contributions to the field. He is the author of *The Meaning of General Education* and co-editor of two editions of *Leading the eLearning Transformation of Higher Education*.
