The good winter hardiness inherited from 'mom' Westerland allows Above All to perform with continuous blooming from spring to fall in multiple climates.

Golden Opportunity™

Color: Yellow, with a hint of Apricot

Flower: Very Full, Double Blooms

Fragrance: Strong Tea like

Size: 8 -12ft

Excellent Disease Resistance

Blooming in flushes throughout the season, pointed, ovoid buds spiral open to reveal gorgeous golden yellow blooms that shine like beacons against a backdrop of glossy, deep green leaves. You won't regret giving this rose a chance to show off in your garden. This is a very exciting new everblooming climbing rose in an amazing colour and modest 10 foot plant habit.



Lady In Red™

Color: Dark red suffused with occasional black smoke

This plant is well contained and more compact than many Climbers. The lady was born and raised in the USA, with her flowers bearing the true classic AMERICAN red coloration. The large ruffled old-fashioned blossoms will take your breath away and falling in love with this lady is the only possible outcome.



Purple Splash™

Color: Wine-purple speckled & striped with white

Flower: Medium, mostly single about 4in. In diameter

A whole new color in Climbers! Imagine Weeks' famous Fourth of July rose in shades of purple. Although they're distantly related, this kissin' cousin blooms in even larger, more pyramid-shaped clusters of flowers & doesn't have nearly the thorns. Set these splashy colors against bright Granny Smith-green foliage & you've got a killer combo for any fence, wall or trellis. Vigorous, clean & free-flowering...it repeat blooms readily in the very first year. More stripes show up in cooler weather.



Sally Holmes

Color: Buff buds open pure white

Flower: Large, single, 5-8 petals

Fragrance: Moderately Fragrant

Size: 6-12ft

Zone: 5 - 9

Very Disease Resistant.

Unlike any rose you've seen, Sally gives huge clusters that resemble Hydrangea heads—filled with buff-colored buds that open to white single flowers. Despite their frail appearance, the blooms last well even in heat. Vigorous, disease resistant and very free flowering. Blooms on new wood. Good in most temperature. Deeper bud color when cool.



Westerland

Color: Blended Apricot and Orange

Flower: Medium, Ruffled 18 -25 petals

Fragrance: Very Fragrant

Very Disease Resistance

For years, Westerland has been passed lovingly from one rose-lover to the next, earning its place in rosedom. Her reputation is based on terrific fragrance, glossy green highly disease-resistant foliage, great natural hardiness, large sprays of brightly colored blossoms and super vigor. Blooms and reblooms freely in the first season on both new and old wood. Can get very large in mild climates.



White Dawn

Color: Ivory White

Flower: Double, Hybrid Tea Form

Loads of bright white ruffled flowers come on this vigorous disease-resistant plant. Blooms on new and old wood. Free-flowering proven performer. First introduced in 1949.

FLORIBUNDA



CINCO DE MAYO

Color: Indescribable blend of rust-red lavender-smoke

Flower: 3.5in. 20-25 petal count

Fragrance: Mild, sweet apple scent

Size: 3-4ft

Zones: 5-10

Excellent Disease Resistance

This seedling of Julia Child puts a whole new spin on 'flower power'. The clusters of blooms never stop poppin' open on this powerfully flowerful Floribunda. Mysteriously colored & deliriously novel...it's an indescribable blending of smoked lavender & rusty red-orange. The super-clean glossy-green foliage mirrors the flowers, adding even more pizzazz to this bushy rounded flower factory. Smokier when it's cool outside.



COLORIFIC

Color: Shades of coral, salmon & peach that blush all red

Flower: 4-5in, 30 petal count

Fragrance: Slightly Fruity

Size: 4-4.5ft

Zones: 5-10

Very Good Disease Resistance.

Big pointed buds swirl open to show off seductive shades of peach, coral & salmon. But the color display doesn't stop there. The sun 'suntans' each petal...blushing them into deeper tones of orange, scarlet & burgundy. Long stems make it a great addition to any cutting garden. Best flower size in cooler conditions.



DISTANT DRUMS

Color: Warm tan washed with orchid-pink on the outer petals

Flower: 3-3.5in, 35-40 petal count

Fragrance: Myrr

Size: 3-4ft

Zones: 5-9

Very Good Disease Resistance

Here's a striking color amongst the hardy roses released by the late Dr. Griffith Buck. Distant Drums grows much like a Floribunda in habit, drumming out clusters of pointed brunette buds that swirl open to reveal ruffles washed with orchid pink. All this set to music against dark green foliage makes for a toe-tapping commotion in the landscape.



DORIS DAY

Color: Pure even Gold-Yellow

Flower: Up to 4.5in, 45-55 petal count

Fragrance: Sweet Fruit and Spice

Size: 3-5ft

Zones: 5 or 6-9

Good Disease Resistance

Doris Day's blooms are full of sunshine and will sweeten up your garden with their fruity and sweet spice aroma. The old-fashioned blooms are produced in beautiful rounded clusters on vigorous stems. You get to enjoy the gold yellow coloration until the petals drop.



FOREVER AMBER™

Color: Unique Toffee-Apricot

Flower: Old Fashioned, 50-150 petal count

Fragrance: Strong Fruity

Size: 1.5-3ft

Zones: 5-9

Good Disease Resistance

While the bloom of this rose may not hold their warm apricot color forever, they certainly hold it well, even when temperatures soar. Perfect for adding a bit of sparkle to cut flower bouquets, the old-fashioned blooms adorn upright, slightly spreading plants in such abundance that you'll have plenty of leftovers to enjoy in the garden. Lush, green foliage has excellent tolerance to powdery mildew.



Hot Cocoa™

Color: Smoky Chocolate-Orange

Flower: 4in. Double, 25-30 petal count

Fragrance: Fruity

Mysterious, indescribable, elusive...whatever!
There's just no other rose color quite like this.

Pointed buds of deep rust unfurl to reveal a chocolate haze of velvety smoked tones that can even take on a purply cast. Set against gobs of glossy foliage, the ruffled fragrant flowers are mirrored by super-green leaves. Easy vigor and natural disease-resistance make it a must for every garden. Keeps on smokin' even when the weather turns warm.

Color: Novel Plum-Purple

Flower: Double, 25-30 petal count

Fragrance: Powerful Citrus and Rose

Size: 2.5-5ft

Extraordinary and truly intriguing! No other modern rose captures the deep purple-red bud and velvety plum flower color of this award winner. And it pleases the nose as well with a powerful perfume of citrus and rose. Dark green leaves enrobe the bushy rounded plant. Established plants give more blooms & best color.



Judy Garland

Color: Yellow blushing to hot orange & scarlet

Flower: Medium, 30-35 petal count

Fragrance: Sweetly Fragrant

Size: 4-5ft

Good Disease Resistance

No need to look 'over the rainbow' when you can have this sweetly fragrant rainbow in your own garden. She belts out a seemingly endless dazzling display of multicolored yellows, oranges and reds. Glossy 'Oz' green leaves costume the bushy prolific plant. An outstanding performer! Showy. Blush color can burn in strong sun.

Liven up your garden and delight your senses with this English-style shrub rose. Its bright yellow blooms entertain the eye and age with a blush of pink color. The blossoms exude a fruity fragrance to enjoy. With its rounded, compact and upright form, it brings small spaces and containers to life. Full, dense foliage allows it to double as a low hedge with a 2' spread. This entertainer thrives in hot, dry climates and has good disease resistance



Rosie the Riveter™

Rosie the Riveter pays tribute to the women who worked in factories and shipyards during World War II.

The old-fashioned unusual flowers of orange-gold suffused with pink are surely reminiscent of that era. The exquisite pointy and shapely buds are proudly held on top of very glossy dark foliage as a feminine symbol of charm and strength. The moderate fruity & spice fragrance is the perfect complement to these cultural icons. Like the tireless "Rosies", the even rounded plants of Rosie the Riveter are the workhorse of the garden, producing an arsenal of flowers.



Sentimental™

Color: Burgundy-red swirled with creamy white

Flower: Large, Double, 25-30 petal count

Fragrance: Strong, Sweet Spice

Size: 3-4ft

Zones: 6-9

You might think stripes are a new-fangled thing. But it's the old rose heritage that brings the genetic striping to this spicy scented new-comer. Each petal is as unique as a snowflake—some more burgundy-splashed-white, some more cream-swirled-red—all on the same vigorous plant. The old-fashioned form & fragrance may remind you of its stingy blooming ancestors. Yet the nearly continuous number of blossoms lets you know there's modern kinfolk in there, too. Distinctive clean quilted foliage. Best color & size in moderate temps.



Sheila's Perfume

Color: Yellow edged deep pink

Flower: Large, Double, Hybrid Tea size

Fragrance: Spicy

Very Disease Resistance

Sheila, the hybridizer's wife, must be a lovely lady (and smell mighty nice, too) to equal this gorgeous rose imported from England. Despite the Floribunda classification, her flowers of yellow brushed by deep pink are more like a Hybrid Tea in size and form. And, yes, each blossom is saturated with wonderful fragrance. The vigorous rounded bush is loaded with glossy green leaves. Best flower color & size when cool.
