Anah Kruschke Flower strong reddish purple with a deep purplish red blotch, 3" across, widely funnel-shaped. Held in ball-shaped trusses of 10-12 flowers. Blooms late midseason. Leaves 4½" long, glossy, yellow-green. Rounded habit. Heat & sun tolerant. Typical height: 5 ft. in 10 years. Plant is hardy to -15°F (-26°C).



Blue Baron Rich violet-blue flowers are just a tad more blue than the other R. augustinii hybrids, making this one in demand by purple flower lovers. The plants stays compact, and will have attractive, shiny-green leaves in spring and summer, and go to bronze in the winter. Hardy to -10 degrees, 4ft Tall & Wide



Catawbiense Boursault covered in stunning clusters of lavender trumpetshaped flowers at the ends of the branches in mid spring, which emerge from distinctive violet flower buds. Hardy to -20 degrees, 5ft Tall & Wide



<u>Chionoides</u> A late to mid-season bloomer with large, rounded trusses, each holding a dozen or more clear white bell-shaped flowers with yellow dorsal blotches. The compact, dense form is wider than tall. Hardy to -20 degrees, 4ft Tall x 4-6ft Wide

**'Doc' is a compact, rounded, evergreen shrub with oblong to elliptic, dark green leaves and large, rounded clusters of funnel-shaped, lightly spotted, wavy-margined, rose-pink flowers with darker pink margins, fading to white with age. Hardy to -20 degrees, 3ft Tall & Wide



**Gomer Waterer Small evergreen shrub is a highly valued landscape ornamental. Large trusses of showy flowers - white with pale orchid markings - are a beautiful contrast to the dark green leaves. Hardy to -15 degrees, 6ft Tall & Wide.



**Holden Greets the merry days of midspring with a cavalcade of magnificent rosy pink blossoms. The blooms start out a rich red-pink upon first opening, eventually fading to a lovely sugar-pink. Glossy, dark evergreen leaves complete the picture. Hardy to -20 degrees, 4-6ft Tall & Wide.

**Lord Roberts A large, upright evergreen shrub with rounded trusses of deep crimson, funnel-shaped flowers, marked with black in the throat, opening late spring to early summer. Hardy to -20, 4-5ft Tall & Wide



**Minnetonka This certainly shows off at flower time with its big, beefy globes of pleasingly light purple bloom starting around mid-May. Its tremendous, deep green, shiny foliage is tightly packed on a rounded, well shaped plant that just looks neater and more formal than most other large growing types. Hardy to -20 degrees, 4-6ft Tall & Wide



Nova Zembla A queen in the spring garden with beautiful trusses of red flowers that practically shine on this dense-growing, small evergreen plant. The flashy scarlet flowers will crown this plant each midspring. Hardy to -30 degrees, 6-8ft Tall x 5-7ft Wide.



**Olin O. Dobbs Openly funnel-shaped flowers, 2½" across, waxy, very deep reddish-purple with slight brown spotting. Held in dome-shaped trusses of 12-15 flowers. Hardy to -15 degrees, 5ft in 10 years.

Percy Wiseman This floriferous shrub produces clusters of elegant trumpet-shaped flowers with yellow throats and branches streaked pink at the ends. The plant's blooms will have turned creamy white in late spring. Hardy to -10, 4-5ft Tall & Wide



**Prince Camille de Rohan Early Midseason flowers are funnel-shaped, 2%" across, pale rose pink, with a broad crimson ray on dorsal lobes. Dome-shaped truss holds up to 20 flowers. Hardy to -15, 5ft in 10 years.



Polarnacht Tight, low and spreading, this will mature twice as wide as tall. Leathery, dark green leaves populate its branches and serve as the backdrop for striking, bulbous, branch ending buds that turn nearly black as they expand in mid to late May. When the buds open fully, frilly deep, dark purple flowers form huge trusses that cover the plant with this rare, very showy color. Hardy to -10 degrees, 2-3ft Tall x 5-6ft Wide.



**Rocket This belongs to the group of Large-Flowered Evergreen Hybrid Rhododendrons. These are the drama queens of Spring and early Summer, producing stunning displays of showy flowers in big trusses against a backdrop of bold evergreen foliage. Beautiful, frilly, deep-pink flowers create a stunning contrast against the dark green leaves. Hardy to -20 degrees, 4-6ft T&W

Roseum Pink Smothered in stunning clusters of pink trumpet-shaped flowers with lavender overtones and dark red spots at the ends of the branches in mid spring, which emerge from distinctive purple flower buds. Hardy to -20 degrees, 5ft Tall x 6ft Wide.



**Royal Purple A vigorous shrub with shiny dark green foliage. The purple flowers have a small yellow-orange flare with red spots that gives richness to the color. Here is a plant that grows easily, is very hardy and gets better with age. A purple lover's dream plant! Hardy to -25, 5ft Tall & Wide.



**Vulcan In late spring it is smothered in huge bunches of large, blood-red flowers that turn it into an inferno of color. Hardy to -20 degrees, 5ft Tall & Wide but can eventually reach up to 8 ft.



**Wilgen's Ruby Covered in stunning clusters of lightly-scented, ruby-red, trumpet-shaped flowers with brown spots at the ends of the branches in late spring.Hardy to -15 degrees, 5ft Tall & Wide.

Yaku Prince Spectacular blooms are carried in large bunches at the ends of every stem, and they are bright red in bud, opening to a beautiful pink with soft purple overtones, wavy edges and red spots inside. Its large leaves are covered in silver hairs when they are new, and they have a unique 'suede' underside that is orange-yellow, adding interest. Hardy to -25, 3ft Tall x 4ft Wide.
