

**America** Smothered in stunning clusters of lightly-scented hot pink trumpetshaped flowers with violet overtones and red throats at the ends of the branches from late spring to early summer, which emerge from distinctive red flower buds. It has grayish green evergreen foliage. The narrow leaves remain grayish green throughout the winter. Hardy to -30 degrees, morning sun to

part shade, 5ft tall and wide



**Anah Kruschke** Flower strong reddish purple with a deep purplish red blotch, 3" across, widely funnelshaped. Held in ball-shaped trusses of 10-12 flowers. Blooms late midseason. Leaves 4½" long, glossy, yellow-green. Rounded habit. Heat & sun tolerant. Typical height: 5 ft. in 10 years. Hardy to -15°F



Baden Baden Small clusters of bright red flowers with dark centers cover this plant each spring. Year round foliage is a bright forest green. One of the best dwarf reds.

2ft Tall and Wide, hardy to -15 degrees, Bloom time: Mid-season, Part sun to shade



Black Widow Flower openly funnel-shaped, about 3½" across, wavy edges, opens dark grayish purple aging to darker than dark red with a dark speckled eye. Ball-shaped truss holds 19-21 flowers.

Bloom time: Mid-season, Hardy to -5 degrees, Morning Sun to Filtered Shade Dwarf variety: 3ft in 10 years Stunning color! You have to see it to





Blue Boy Purple often ignites passion in the garden. If you love purple, this is one of the best cultivars. A heavy blooming, upright and open growing, well-shaped plant, that has relatively long, narrow, dark green leaves. The funnel-shaped flowers are vibrant violet with wavy edges and a purple-black blotch. They are held in a tight, rounded truss with up to 20 flowers per truss. It is sun tolerant.

Bloom time: Late, Hardy to -10 degrees



Blue Peter This captivating, evergreen shrub is bathed in clusters of beautiful violet and white blooms with a dark burgundy blotch; an excellent choice to mass in groupings as an elegant focal point of the garden; must have rich acidic soil.

Bloom Time: Mid-season, Hardy to -10 degrees, 4ft tall x 5ft wide, part sun to shade



Catawbiense Boursault covered in stunning clusters of lavender trumpet-shaped flowers at the ends of the branches in mid spring, which emerge from distinctive violet flower buds. Hardy to -20 degrees, 5ft Tall & Wide



<u>Chionoides</u> A late to mid-season bloomer with large, rounded trusses, each holding a dozen or more clear white bell-shaped flowers with yellow dorsal blotches. The compact, dense form is wider than tall. Hardy to -20 degrees, 4ft Tall x 4-6ft Wide



Cunningham's Blush Flower funnel-shaped, about 2" across, pale mauve-pink, marked red and brown, fading to blush pink. Held in lax trusses of 10-17 flowers. Bloom Time: Late Midseason Hardy to Minus 10 degrees: 6ft in 10 years, Can grow to 11 ft. in time



Douglas R. Stephens Flowers are openly funnel-shaped, wavy lobes, 4½" across, strong purplish-red with dark red blotch in throat and spots on 3 dorsal lobes. Held in conical trusses of 14 flowers. Bloom time: Early midseason, 4ft in 10 years, Hardy to -10 degrees



Edith Bosley Large trusses of rich purple flowers flushed magenta and with a darker flair crown this rhododendron cultivar in springtime. Very similar to the popular R. 'Purple Splendour' but is hardier and has larger blossoms. Bloom time: mid-season, 5ft x 5ft in 10 years, 8ft at maturity, hardy to -15 degrees.



Edwin O. Weber Flower flat saucer-shaped, wavy lobes, 3½" across, purple with large vivid yellowish-green blotch on dorsal lobe and green spots on adjacent lobes. Flat trusses hold 28 flowers. Hardy to -5 degrees Bloom time: Late mid-season, 6ft in 10 years



Fire Rim Blooms have a light yellow interior and strong, purplish red edge. Dense growth habit. Very showy shrub. Bloom time: Early Mid-Season, Morning sun to afternoon shade, 3ft in 10 years, Hardy to 0 degrees



Gartendirektor Glocker Flowers are campanulate, 2%" - 2%" across, rose red with darker edges. Truss holds 8-12 flowers. Bloom time: Mid-season, 4ft in 10 years, Hardy to -5 degrees



Ginny Gee This little rhododendron will never outgrow the garden. A lovely low grower perfect for rock gardens or the front of the border, making little mounds of flowers when in full bloom. Excellent as a container plant. Bloom time: early mid-season, Dwarf size 2ft x 2ft, Hardy to -10 degrees



Goldflimmer Lilac-pink trusses with a light yellow flair. This plant though, is probably desired more for its variegated foliage then its flower. Bloom time: Late midseason, 3ft in 10 years, Morning sun to part shade, Hardy to -15 degrees



Graf Zepplin Flower bright pink with darker edges. Held in ball-shaped trusses of about 10 flowers. Bloom time: Late midseason, 5ft in 10 years, Morning sun to shade, Hardy to -10 degrees



H.L. Larson Flowers 5" across, inside brilliant yellow with moderate pink edges, reverse moderate pink, dorsal lobe spotted vivid red. Bloom time: Mid-season, 3ft in 10 years, Morning sun to part shade, Hardy to -10 degrees



**Holden** Greets the merry days of midspring with a cavalcade of magnificent rosy pink blossoms. The blooms start out a rich red-pink upon first opening, eventually fading to a lovely sugar-pink. Glossy, dark evergreen leaves complete the picture. Hardy to -20 degrees, 4-6ft



**Kaitlyn's Delight** A beautiful variety that has peachy-orange blooms that open up in mid spring. Has a nice rounded habit & reaches roughly 3 feet tall. Morning sun to part shade, Hardy to 5 degrees



Ken Janek Large trusses of pink blooms with darker pink edges; attractive fuzzy white terminal buds. Thick, leathery, dark green foliage with velvety, tan undersides. Effective in groups. Bloom time: Mid-season, 3ft tall x 4ft wide in 10 years, Hardy to -20 degrees



Lee's Dark Purple A hardy, compact shrub valued for its deep purple buds that open to large trusses of violet-purple flowers in late May. Dark green leaves with undulating edges nicely frame the colorful spring flowers and provide evergreen interest year-round. Thrives in cooler regions with some protection from winter winds. Bloom time: late mid-season, Morning sun to part shade, 6ft in 10 years, Hardy to -15 degrees



Lord Roberts A large, upright evergreen shrub with rounded trusses of deep crimson, funnel-shaped flowers, marked with black in the throat, opening late spring to early summer. Morning sun to shade, Hardy to -20, 4-5ft Tall & Wide



Minnetonka This certainly shows off at flower time with its big, beefy globes of pleasingly light purple bloom starting around mid-May. Its tremendous, deep green, shiny foliage is tightly packed on a rounded, well shaped plant that just looks neater and more formal than most other large growing types. Hardy to -20 degrees, 4-6ft Tall & Wi



Nova Zembla A queen in the spring garden with beautiful trusses of red flowers that practically shine on this dense-growing, small evergreen plant. The flashy scarlet flowers will crown this plant each mid-spring. Morning sun to shade, Hardy to -30 degrees, 6-8ft Tall x 5-7ft Wide.



Olin O Dobbs Flower openly funnel-shaped, 2½" across, waxy, very deep reddish-purple with slight brown spotting. Held in dome-shaped truss with 12-15 flowers. Bloom time: Mid-season, 5ft in 10 years, Morning sun to shade, Hardy to -15 degrees



Percy Wiseman This floriferous shrub produces clusters of elegant trumpet-shaped flowers with yellow throats and branches streaked pink at the ends. The plant's blooms will have turned creamy white in late spring. Hardy to -10, 4-5ft Tall & Wide



Polarnacht Tight, low and spreading, this will mature twice as wide as tall. Leathery, dark green leaves populate its branches and serve as the backdrop for striking, bulbous, branch ending buds that turn nearly black as they expand in mid to late May. When the buds open fully, frilly deep, dark purple flowers form



Roseum Elegans A vigorous cold-hardy rhododendron, with long, glossy evergreen leaves. It flowers spectacularly in May or June, with big, bold trusses of many large blooms. They are a wonderful lilac-purple color, turning more pink-purple as they mature. It forms a handsome rounded bush 6-8 ft tall and wide, looking almost as lovely when not in bloom as when it is. Perfect for beds, foundation planting and woodland areas. Morning sun to part shade, Hardy to -20 degrees



Roseum Pink Smothered in stunning clusters of pink trumpet-shaped flowers with lavender overtones and dark red spots at the end of the branches in mid spring, which emerge from distinctive purple flower buds. Morning sun to shade, Hardy to -20 degrees, 5ft Tall x 6ft Wide



**Royal Pink** Flower openly funnelshaped, about 3" across, deep purplish pink, inside is darker. Truss has 5-6 flowers. Bloom time: Mid-season, 3ft in 10 years, Morning sun to shade, Hardy to -10 degrees



Seaview Sunset A "wow" color combination. Red-orange buds open yellow with a band of red-orange on the edges. A deep salmon coloration highlights the back of the petals. Leaves are a semi-glossy green. Bloom time: early to mid-season, 3ft in 10 years, Hardy to 0 degrees



Stenopetalum-Spider Azalea A unique evergreen flowering shrub. The leaves are very spider like, but it is the pink spider-like blooms that appear in the fall that make this extra amazing. These pink red blooms are crazy and unique. Rhododendron stenopetalum may reach 4-5 ft in height and width in 10 years. Part shade, Hardy to 5 degrees



<u>Titian Beauty</u> Charming bright red flowers and shiny jade green foliage on a compact plant make this a delightful addition to your garden. Bloom time: mid-season, 3ft tall and wide, Hardy to -5 degrees, Morning sun to shade



**Virginia Richards** Flower long lasting, openly funnel-shaped, 4½" across, open rosy-pink aging to apricot and then yellow, pinkish-red spotting. Ball-shaped truss with 10-12 flowers. Bloom time: Mid-season, 4ft in 10 years, Hardy to 0 degrees, Part sun to part shade



<u>Vulcan</u> In late spring it is smothered in huge bunches of large, blood-red flowers that turn it into an inferno of color. Hardy to -20 degrees, 5ft Tall & Wide but can eventually reach up to 8 ft., Morning sun to shade



**Wine and Roses** The undersides of the leaves are wine red and very complimentary to the outstanding blooms of a clear rose, pinkish red. Bloom time Mid-season, 4ft in 10 years, Part sun to part shade, Hardy to 0 degrees



Yaku Sunrise Covered in stunning clusters of shell pink trumpet-shaped flowers with white overtones and hot pink edges at the ends of the branches in mid spring. It has dark green evergreen foliage. Morning sun to part shade, Mid-season bloom time, 3 to 4ft tall and wide, Hardy to -10 degrees
